

Associations of "Spatial" (30 Words)

allocate	Distribute (resources or duties) for a particular purpose. Students are allocate d accommodation on a yearly basis.
allocation	The act of distributing by allotting or apportioning; distribution according to a plan. Unclaimed allocations would be held for three years.
allotment	The action of allotting something. The allotment of equity securities.
apportionment	The action or result of apportioning something. The apportionment of seats in the House of Representatives is based on the relative population of each state.



building	The occupants of a building. His hobby was the building of boats.
contiguity	The sequential occurrence or proximity of stimulus and response, causing their association in the mind. <i>Nations bound together by geographical contiguity.</i>
cumulative	Increasing or increased in quantity, degree, or force by successive additions. <i>The benefits are cumulative</i> .
<u>diffusion</u>	(physics) the process in which there is movement of a substance from an area of high concentration of that substance to an area of lower concentration. The rate of diffusion of a gas.
<u>dimension</u>	An expression for a derived physical quantity in terms of fundamental quantities such as mass length or time raised to the appropriate power acceleration for example having the dimension of length time. <i>The final dimensions of the pond were 14 ft x 8 ft.</i>
<u>dispersion</u>	The extent to which values of a variable differ from a fixed value such as the mean. The virus is transmitted in the dispersion of droplets which results from sneezing or coughing.
dissemination	The property of being diffused or dispersed. The dissemination of public information.
distribution	An arrangement of values of a variable showing their observed or theoretical frequency of occurrence. <i>Unequal distributions of income and wealth.</i>
earmark	Identification mark on the ear of a domestic animal. I will earmark this money for your research.
equitable	Fair to all parties as dictated by reason and conscience. An equitable distribution of gifts among the children.
gap	Make an opening or gap in. There are many gap s in our understanding of what happened.
gill	Catch a fish in a gill net.
interval	A component of activity in interval training. An interval of mourning.
<u>matrix</u>	(mathematics) a rectangular array of quantities or expressions set out by rows and columns; treated as a single element and manipulated according to rules. The matrix of gravel paths is hoed regularly.



opening	The act of opening something. There was a small opening between the trees.
part	A melody or other constituent of harmony assigned to a particular voice or instrument in a musical work. The friends separated after the part y.
percentage	An amount, such as an allowance or commission, that is a proportion of a larger sum of money. <i>I hope to be on a percentage</i> .
proportion	Give pleasant proportions to. A building of vast proportion s.
<u>quantity</u>	The figure or symbol representing a quantity. <i>He had a quantity of ammunition.</i>
quota	(in a system of proportional representation) the minimum number of votes required to elect a candidate. All the salesmen met their quota for the month.
range	Range or extend over occupy a certain area. A wood burning kitchen range .
<u>room</u>	Share a room house or flat especially a rented one at a college or similar institution. <i>The whole room was cheering.</i>
share	Have give or receive a share of. I d like to share this idea with you.
space	One of two possible states of a signal in certain systems. <i>The laboratory s floor space</i> .
structure	Give a structure to. <i>He has good bone structure.</i>
<u>widening</u>	The act of making something wider.
