- *The head and sharpened point of a spear.*
- *The leading military unit in an attack.*
- *The point of a spear.*

driving force	The act of controlling and steering the movement of a vehicle or animal.
leader	A length of filament attached to the end of a fishing line to carry the hook or fly. <i>The leader of a protest group.</i>
leaders	A person who rules or guides or inspires others. <i>The national leadership adopted his plan.</i>
spear point	An implement with a shaft and barbed point used for catching fish.
spear tip	An implement with a shaft and barbed point used for catching fish.
spear-point	The head and sharpened point of a spear.
spearpoint	The head and sharpened point of a spear.
