- *A distinguishing trait.*
- *A product, especially a type of food, which a person or region is famous for making well.*
- *A contract under seal.*
- *A branch of medicine or surgery.*



## Synonyms of "Speciality" as a noun (23 Words)

<b>area</b>	A space allocated for a specific use. <i>It was a mountainous area.</i>
<b>area of specialization</b>	The extent of a 2-dimensional surface enclosed within a boundary.
<b>bent</b>	A special way of doing something. <i>He had a <b>bent</b> for it.</i>
<b>branch of knowledge</b>	A stream or river connected to a larger one.
<b>claim to fame</b>	An assertion of a right (as to money or property).
<b>department</b>	An area of special expertise or responsibility. <i>Baking is not my <b>department</b>.</i>
<b>distinctiveness</b>	Utter dissimilarity. <i>Communities are keen to maintain cultural <b>distinctiveness</b>.</i>
<b>field of study</b>	All the competitors in a particular contest or sporting event.
<b>forte</b>	The stronger part of a sword blade between the hilt and the foible. <i>Cooking is his <b>forte</b>.</i>
<b>gift</b>	An act of giving something as a present. <i>That goal was an absolute <b>gift</b>.</i>
<b>medical field</b>	A thorough physical examination; includes a variety of tests depending on the age and sex and health of the person.
<b>metier</b>	An occupation for which you are especially well suited. <i>In law he found his true <b>metier</b>.</i>
<b>métier</b>	An asset of special worth or utility.
<b>peculiarity</b>	Something unusual — perhaps worthy of collecting. <i>His essays characterized decency as a British <b>peculiarity</b>.</i>
<b>pièce de résistance</b>	The outstanding item (the prize piece or main exhibit) in a collection.
<b>skill</b>	An ability that has been acquired by training. <i>Difficult work taking great <b>skill</b>.</i>
<b>specialisation</b>	The special line of work you have adopted as your career.
<b>specialism</b>	The concentration of your efforts on a particular field of study or occupation. <i>One of her areas of <b>specialism</b> is police reform.</i>
<b>specialization</b>	The structural adaptation of some body part for a particular function. <i>The way different muscles are constructed allows for <b>specialization</b> of function.</i>

**specialness**

A distinguishing trait.

**specialty**

The special line of work you have adopted as your career.

**strength**

The capacity of an object or substance to withstand great force or pressure.

*The solution comes in two **strengths**.*

**talent**

A person who possesses unusual innate ability in some field or activity.

*I signed all the **talent** in Rome.*
