- *A product, especially a type of food, which a person or region is famous for making well.*
- *A contract under seal.*
- *A branch of medicine or surgery.*



Synonyms of "Speciality" as a noun (23 Words)

area	A space allocated for a specific use. <i>It was a mountainous area.</i>
area of specialization	The extent of a 2-dimensional surface enclosed within a boundary.
<u>bent</u>	A special way of doing something. <i>He had a bent for it.</i>
branch of knowledge	A stream or river connected to a larger one.
claim to fame	An assertion of a right (as to money or property).
department	An area of special expertise or responsibility. <i>Baking is not my department.</i>
distinctiveness	Utter dissimilarity. <i>Communities are keen to maintain cultural distinctiveness.</i>
field of study	All the competitors in a particular contest or sporting event.
<u>forte</u>	The stronger part of a sword blade between the hilt and the foible. <i>Cooking is his forte.</i>
gift	An act of giving something as a present. <i>That goal was an absolute gift.</i>
medical field	A thorough physical examination; includes a variety of tests depending on the age and sex and health of the person.
metier	An occupation for which you are especially well suited. <i>In law he found his true metier.</i>
métier	An asset of special worth or utility.
peculiarity	Something unusual — perhaps worthy of collecting. <i>His essays characterized decency as a British peculiarity.</i>
pièce de résistance	The outstanding item (the prize piece or main exhibit) in a collection.
skill	An ability that has been acquired by training. <i>Difficult work taking great skill.</i>
specialisation	The special line of work you have adopted as your career.
specialism	The concentration of your efforts on a particular field of study or occupation. <i>One of her areas of specialism is police reform.</i>
specialization	The structural adaptation of some body part for a particular function. <i>The way different muscles are constructed allows for specialization of function.</i>

specialness

A distinguishing trait.

specialty

The special line of work you have adopted as your career.

strength

The capacity of an object or substance to withstand great force or pressure.

*The solution comes in two **strengths**.*

talent

A person who possesses unusual innate ability in some field or activity.

*I signed all the **talent** in Rome.*
