- A contract under seal.
- A branch of medicine or surgery.

metier An occupation for which you are especially well suited.

peculiarity Something unusual — perhaps worthy of collecting.

His essays characterized decency as a British **peculiarity**.

pièce de résistance

The outstanding item (the prize piece or main exhibit) in a

collection.

skill An ability that has been acquired by training.

specialisation The special line of work you have adopted as your career.

The concentration of your efforts on a particular field of study or

specialism occupation.

One of her areas of **specialism** is police reform.

The structural adaptation of some body part for a particular
