alluvial	Relating to or derived from alluvium. <i>Rich alluvial soils.</i>
appendage	A part that is joined to something larger. <i>They treat Scotland as a mere appendage of England.</i>
circumstantial	Pointing indirectly towards someone's guilt but not conclusively proving it. <i>The picture was so circumstantial that it began to be convincing.</i>
classifiable	Capable of being classified.
clearly	Clear to the mind; with distinct mental discernment. <i>I could clearly see myself in his situation.</i>
corresponding	Accompanying. <i>All rights carry with them corresponding responsibilities.</i>
culturally	With regard to a culture. <i>A culturally vibrant city.</i>
defined	Clearly characterized or delimited. <i>Defined boundaries.</i>
definition	The capacity of a device to make images distinct in outline. <i>The clarity and definition of pictures can be aided by using computer graphics.</i>

differentia	An attribute that distinguishes a species of thing from other species of the same genus.
differentiated	Made different (especially in the course of development) or shown to be different.
disambiguate	State unambiguously or remove ambiguities from. <i>Can you disambiguate this statement.</i>
distinct	Clearly or sharply defined to the mind. <i>The ship appeared as a distinct silhouette.</i>
<u>distinctive</u>	Characteristic of one person or thing, and so serving to distinguish it from others. <i>Juniper berries give gin its distinctive flavour.</i>
<u>distinguish</u>	Be a distinctive feature, attribute, or trait; sometimes in a very positive sense. <i>Many distinguished themselves in the fight against Hitler.</i>
especial	Better or greater than usual; special. <i>He paid especial attention to her.</i>
expertise	Expert skill or knowledge in a particular field. <i>Technical expertise.</i>
<u>field</u>	Used in names of animals or plants found in the open country rather than among buildings or as cultivated varieties e.g. field mouse. <i>Fifty white stars on a blue field.</i>
flimsy	Lacking substance or significance. <i>The flimsy garment fell from her.</i>
generality	The quality or state of being general. <i>Policy should be formulated at an appropriate level of generality.</i>
identifiable	Able to be recognized; distinguishable. <i>There are no easily identifiable features on the shoreline.</i>
inconclusive	Not conclusive; not putting an end to doubt or question. <i>Inconclusive evidence.</i>
know	Have firsthand knowledge of states situations emotions or sensations. <i>I want to know who is winning the game.</i>
localized	Confined or restricted to a particular location. <i>Symptoms include localized pain and numbness.</i>
obvious	Easily perceived or understood; clear, self-evident, or apparent. <i>Unemployment has been the most obvious cost of the recession.</i>

- particular** Insisting that something should be correct or suitable in every detail; fastidious.
*Has a **particular** preference for Chinese art.*
- pinpoint** A tiny dot or point.
*Can you **pinpoint** the position of the enemy.*
- recognizable** Able to be recognized or identified from previous encounters or knowledge.
*This situation produces **recognizable** stress symptoms.*
- respective** Considered individually.
*The **respective** club members.*
- specific** A medicine that has a mitigating effect on a specific disease.
*I wish I d put more thought into the **specifics**.*
