Speed in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **speed** We **speed**
You **speed** You **speed**
He/She/It **speeds** They **speed**

Speed in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am speeding** We **are speeding**
You **are speeding** You **are speeding**
He/She/It **is speeding** They **are speeding**

Speed in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

He/She/It **sped (especially us) or speeded (mostly uk)**

Plural

They **sped (especially us) or speeded (mostly uk)**

Speed in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I **was speeding**

You **were speeding**

He/She/It **was speeding**

Plural

We **were speeding**

You **were speeding**

They **were speeding**

You **had sped (especially us) or speeded (mostly uk)**

He/She/It **had sped (especially us) or speeded (mostly uk)**

Speed in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

I **will speed**

You **will speed**

He/She/It **will speed**

Plural

We **will speed**

You **will speed**

They **will speed**

Speed in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I will be speeding

You will be speeding

He/She/It will be speeding

Plural

We will be speeding

You will be speeding

They will be speeding

Speed in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

**I will have sped (especially us) or
speeded (mostly uk)**

**You will have sped (especially us) or
speeded (mostly uk)**

**He/She/It will have sped (especially us) or
speeded (mostly uk)**

Plural

**We will have sped (especially us) or
speeded (mostly uk)**

**You will have sped (especially us) or
speeded (mostly uk)**

**They will have sped (especially us) or
speeded (mostly uk)**

Speed in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

I will have been speeding

You will have been speeding

He/She/It will have been speeding

Plural

We will have been speeding

You will have been speeding

They will have been speeding
