dapper	Neat and trim in dress and appearance (typically used of a man). A dapper <i>young man.</i>
dashing	Attractive, adventurous, and full of confidence (typically used of a man). A dashing <i>black fedora.</i>
elegant	Graceful and stylish in appearance or manner. She was elegant <i>to her fingertips.</i>

glamorous	Having an air of allure, romance and excitement. <i>Being a singer must be such a glamorous lifestyle.</i>
high-class	Pretentiously elegant.
high-toned	Pretentiously elegant.
jaunty	Having or expressing a lively, cheerful, and self-confident manner. <i>Walked with a jaunty step.</i>
natty	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners. <i>A palmtop computer with many natty features.</i>
raffish	Unconventional and slightly disreputable, especially in an attractive way. <i>His raffish air.</i>
rakish	Marked by a carefree unconventionality or disreputableness. <i>He had a rakish debonair look.</i>
smart	Quick; brisk. <i>Smart children talk earlier than the average.</i>
snappy	Apt to speak irritably. <i>Snappy weather.</i>
spruce	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners.
stylish	Being or in accordance with current social fashions. <i>He put his heart and soul into a stylish performance.</i>
