<b>dashing</b>	Attractive, adventurous, and full of confidence (typically used of a man). A <b>dashing</b> <i>black fedora.</i>
<b>elegant</b>	Graceful and stylish in appearance or manner. She was <b>elegant</b> <i>to her fingertips.</i>

<b>glamorous</b>	Having an air of allure, romance and excitement. <i>Being a singer must be such a <b>glamorous</b> lifestyle.</i>
<b>high-class</b>	Pretentiously elegant.
<b>high-toned</b>	Pretentiously elegant.
<b>jaunty</b>	Having or expressing a lively, cheerful, and self-confident manner. <i>Walked with a <b>jaunty</b> step.</i>
<b>natty</b>	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners. <i>A palmtop computer with many <b>natty</b> features.</i>
<b>raffish</b>	Unconventional and slightly disreputable, especially in an attractive way. <i>His <b>raffish</b> air.</i>
<b>rakish</b>	Marked by a carefree unconventionality or disreputableness. <i>He had a <b>rakish</b> debonair look.</i>
<b>smart</b>	Quick; brisk. <i><b>Smart</b> children talk earlier than the average.</i>
<b>snappy</b>	Apt to speak irritably. <i><b>Snappy</b> weather.</i>
<b>spruce</b>	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners.
<b>stylish</b>	Being or in accordance with current social fashions. <i>He put his heart and soul into a <b>stylish</b> performance.</i>
