classy	Elegant and fashionable- Julia Child. A <b>classy</b> dame.
<u>dapper</u>	Neat and trim in dress and appearance (typically used of a man. A <b>dapper</b> young man.
dashing	Attractive, adventurous, and full of confidence (typically used of a man. A <b>dashing</b> black fedora.
elegant	Graceful and stylish in appearance or manner. She was <b>elegant</b> to her fingertips.



glamorous	Having an air of allure, romance and excitement. Being a singer must be such a <b>glamorous</b> lifestyle.
high-class	Pretentiously elegant.
high-toned	l Pretentiously elegant.
jaunty	Having or expressing a lively, cheerful, and self-confident manner. <i>Walked with a <b>jaunty</b> step.</i>
natty	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners. A palmtop computer with many <b>natty</b> features.
raffish	Unconventional and slightly disreputable, especially in an attractive way. <i>His <b>raffish</b> air.</i>
rakish	Marked by a carefree unconventionality or disreputableness. <i>He had a <b>rakish</b> debonair look.</i>
smart	Quick; brisk. <b>Smart</b> children talk earlier than the average.
<u>snappy</u>	Apt to speak irritably. <b>Snappy</b> weather.
spruce	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners.
<u>stylish</u>	Being or in accordance with current social fashions. He put his heart and soul into a <b>stylish</b> performance.
