### Definitions of "Spire" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “spire” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A tapering conical or pyramidal structure on the top of a building, typically a church tower.*
- *The continuation of a tree trunk above the point where branching begins, especially in a tree of a tapering form.*
- *A tall tower that forms the superstructure of a building (usually a church or temple) and that tapers to a point at the top.*
- *A long tapering object.*



## Synonyms of "Spire" as a noun (2 Words)

**belfry** A room (often at the top of a tower) where bells are hung.

**steeple** A spire on the top of a church tower or roof.



## Usage Examples of "Spire" as a noun

- *Spires of delphiniums.*

- architectural** Of or pertaining to the art and science of architecture.  
*He liked **architectural** plants particularly large spiky palms.*
- behemoth** A huge or monstrous creature.  
***Behemoths** like the brontosaurus.*
- bridge** Make a bridge across.  
*New initiatives were needed to **bridge** the great abyss of class.*
- carillon** A tune played on a carillon.
- column** A vertical glass tube used in column chromatography a mixture is poured in the top and washed through a stationary substance where components of the mixture are adsorbed selectively to form colored bands.  
*A **column** of tanks moved north west.*
- corinthian** Or pertaining to the Corinthian style of architecture.

<b>elevated</b>	Of high moral or intellectual value elevated in nature or style. <i>An <b>elevated</b> temperature.</i>
<b>gangling</b>	Tall and thin. <i>A <b>gangling</b> teenager.</i>
<b>gangly</b>	Tall and thin and having long slender limbs.
<b>lanky</b>	Tall and thin and having long slender limbs. <i>A <b>lanky</b> kid transformed almost overnight into a handsome young man.</i>
<b>leviathan</b>	An autocratic monarch or state. <i>It s a challenge to navigate a wheeled <b>leviathan</b> in rush hour traffic.</i>
<b>lighthouse</b>	A tower or other structure containing a beacon light to warn or guide ships at sea.
<b>lofty</b>	Of a noble or elevated nature. <i><b>Lofty</b> mountains.</i>
<b>masonry</b>	Freemasonry. <i>Cracks in the finished <b>masonry</b>.</i>
<b>mast</b>	Nuts of forest trees (as beechnuts and acorns) accumulated on the ground.
<b>obelisk</b>	A mountain tree or other natural object resembling an obelisk in shape.
<b>pagoda</b>	An ornamental imitation of a Hindu or Buddhist pagoda.
<b>pillar</b>	Something shaped like a pillar. <i>A <b>pillar</b> of rock.</i>
<b>prop</b>	A propeller that rotates to push against air. <i>He found himself becoming the emotional <b>prop</b> of the marriage.</i>
<b>pylon</b>	A tower for guiding pilots or marking the turning point in a race. <i>Power <b>pylons</b> are a favorite target for terrorists.</i>
<b>sculpture</b>	A work of art made by sculpture. <i>A bronze <b>sculpture</b>.</i>
<b>skyscraper</b>	A very tall building of many storeys.
<b>statuesque</b>	(of a woman) attractively tall, graceful, and dignified. <i>Frozen <b>statuesque</b> attitudes.</i>
<b>structure</b>	Give a structure to. <i>The company s weakness is the inflexibility of its management <b>structure</b>.</i>
<b>tall</b>	A garment size for a tall person. <i>How <b>tall</b> are you.</i>
<b>tower</b>	Anything that approximates the shape of a column or tower. <i>He seemed to <b>tower</b> over everyone else.</i>

- towering** Of imposing height; especially standing out above others.  
***Towering** icebergs.*
- trestle** Each of a pair of horizontal pieces on a sailing ship's lower mast supporting the topmast.
- turret** A low armoured tower, typically one that revolves, for a gun and gunners in a ship, aircraft, fort, or tank.  
*A castle with fairy tale **turrets**.*
- willowy** Bordered, shaded, or covered by willows.  
*A beautiful **willowy** blonde.*
