Synonyms of "Spirituality" as a noun (5 Words)

church property A place for public (especially Christian) worship.

otherworldliness Concern with things of the spirit.

spiritism Concern with things of the spirit.

spiritualism The belief that the spirits of dead people can communicate with people who are still alive (especially via a medium).

spirituality Property or income owned by a church.

healer	Something that alleviates distress or anguish. <i>A spiritual healer and medium.</i>
incorporeal	Without material form or substance. <i>An incorporeal spirit.</i>
massage	Give a massage to. <i>Massage can ease tiredness.</i>
mentor	Serve as a teacher or trusted counselor. <i>Mentoring should be encouraged.</i>
osteopath	A therapist who manipulates the skeleton and muscles.
podiatrist	A person who treats the feet and their ailments; a chiropodist. <i>If a toe has a discharge it is likely infected and needs to be treated by a podiatrist.</i>
pontiff	The head of the Roman Catholic Church. <i>The Pope s first visit to Poland as pontiff.</i>
preternatural	Surpassing the ordinary or normal - George Will. <i>Autumn had arrived with preternatural speed.</i>
protege	A person who receives support and protection from an influential patron who furthers the protege s career.
psychiatrist	A medical practitioner specializing in the diagnosis and treatment of mental illness.
psychology	The mental characteristics or attitude of a person or group. <i>The psychology of child killers.</i>
sane	Mentally healthy; free from mental disorder. <i>Hard work kept me sane.</i>

schizophrenia	A long-term mental disorder of a type involving a breakdown in the relation between thought, emotion, and behaviour, leading to faulty perception, inappropriate actions and feelings, withdrawal from reality and personal relationships into fantasy and delusion, and a sense of mental fragmentation. <i>Gibraltar s schizophrenia continues to be fed by colonial pride.</i>
soul	The human embodiment of something. <i>It was bad news for some poor soul.</i>
specialist	A person highly trained in a particular branch of medicine. <i>You may require specialist financial advice.</i>
spectral	Of or relating to a spectrum. <i>A spectral menacing face.</i>
supernatural	Supernatural forces and events and beings collectively. <i>A supernatural being.</i>
<u>teacher</u>	A person whose occupation is teaching. <i>Experience is a demanding teacher.</i>
<u>therapist</u>	A person who treats psychological problems a psychotherapist. <i>A certified massage therapist.</i>
transcendental	Existing outside of or not in accordance with nature-Aldous Huxley. <i>Find transcendental motives for sublunary action.</i>
<u>tutor</u>	Act as a tutor to a single pupil or a very small group. <i>A guitar tutor.</i>
