**otherworldliness** Concern with things of the spirit.

**spiritism** Concern with things of the spirit.

**spiritualism** The belief that the spirits of dead people can communicate with people who are still alive (especially via a medium).

**spirituality** Property or income owned by a church.

<b>educator</b>	Someone who educates young people. <i>The perspective of a professional <b>educator</b>.</i>
<b>faith</b>	An institution to express belief in a divine power. <i>Men with strong political <b>faiths</b>.</i>
<b>guru</b>	Each of the first ten leaders of the Sikh religion. <i>A <b>guru</b> of genomics.</i>
<b>healer</b>	Something that alleviates distress or anguish. <i>A spiritual <b>healer</b> and medium.</i>
<b>incorporeal</b>	Without material form or substance. <i>An <b>incorporeal</b> spirit.</i>
<b>massage</b>	Give a massage to. <i><b>Massage</b> can ease tiredness.</i>
<b>mentor</b>	Serve as a teacher or trusted counselor. <i><b>Mentoring</b> should be encouraged.</i>
<b>osteopath</b>	A therapist who manipulates the skeleton and muscles.
<b>podiatrist</b>	A person who treats the feet and their ailments; a chiropodist. <i>If a toe has a discharge it is likely infected and needs to be treated by a <b>podiatrist</b>.</i>
<b>pontiff</b>	The head of the Roman Catholic Church. <i>The Pope s first visit to Poland as <b>pontiff</b>.</i>
<b>preternatural</b>	Surpassing the ordinary or normal - George Will. <i>Autumn had arrived with <b>preternatural</b> speed.</i>
<b>protege</b>	A person who receives support and protection from an influential patron who furthers the protege s career.
<b>psychiatrist</b>	A medical practitioner specializing in the diagnosis and treatment of mental illness.
<b>psychology</b>	The mental characteristics or attitude of a person or group. <i>The <b>psychology</b> of child killers.</i>
<b>sane</b>	Mentally healthy; free from mental disorder. <i>Hard work kept me <b>sane</b>.</i>

<b>schizophrenia</b>	A long-term mental disorder of a type involving a breakdown in the relation between thought, emotion, and behaviour, leading to faulty perception, inappropriate actions and feelings, withdrawal from reality and personal relationships into fantasy and delusion, and a sense of mental fragmentation. <i>Gibraltar s <b>schizophrenia</b> continues to be fed by colonial pride.</i>
<b>soul</b>	The human embodiment of something. <i>It was bad news for some poor <b>soul</b>.</i>
<b>specialist</b>	A person highly trained in a particular branch of medicine. <i>You may require <b>specialist</b> financial advice.</i>
<b>spectral</b>	Of or relating to a spectrum. <i>A <b>spectral</b> menacing face.</i>
<b>supernatural</b>	Supernatural forces and events and beings collectively. <i>A <b>supernatural</b> being.</i>
<a href="#"><u>teacher</u></a>	A person whose occupation is teaching. <i>Experience is a demanding <b>teacher</b>.</i>
