Lacking consistency.

wood with an uneven grain.

occasional Employed for a particular occasion or on an irregular basis.

The **occasional** car went by but no taxis.

The deductional out world by but no turns

Now and then or here and there.

We met up occasionally for a drink.

**oddity** A strange or peculiar person or thing.

She was regarded as a bit of an **oddity**.

Many times at short intervals.
