Definitions of "Sprawling" as a noun

- *An ungainly posture with arms and legs spread about.*



Synonyms of "Sprawling" as a noun (1 Word)

sprawl An aggregation or continuous network of urban communities.
*She fell into a sort of luxurious **sprawl**.*



Sprawling as an Adjective

Definitions of "Sprawling" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "sprawling" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Spreading out in different directions.*
- *Spreading out in different directions or distributed irregularly.*
- *Spreading out over a large area in an untidy or irregular way.*



Synonyms of "Sprawling" as an adjective (3 Words)

rambling Spreading out in different directions or distributed irregularly.
*A **rambling** speech about this and that.*

straggling Spreading out in different directions or distributed irregularly.
*A long **straggling** village.*

straggly Spreading out in different directions.
***Straggly** hair.*



Usage Examples of "Sprawling" as an adjective

- *Sprawling handwriting.*
- *The sprawling suburbs.*
