Squish as a Verb

Definitions of "Squish" as a verb

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "squish" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- Make a soft squelching sound when walked on or in.
- Yield or cause to yield easily to pressure; squash.
- Walk through mud or mire.
- *Put (a liquid) into a container or another place by means of a squirting action.*





Synonyms of "Squish" as a verb (5 Words)

slop	Feed slops to an animal. The indignity of slop ping out.
slosh	Walk through mud or mire. She slosh ed coffee into a cracked cup.
splash	Make a splashing sound. Water was splash ing on the floor.
splosh	Walk through mud or mire. We had to splosh across the wet meadow.
<u>squelch</u>	Forcefully silence or suppress. Bedraggled guests squelch ed across the lawn to seek shelter.





Usage Examples of "Squish" as a verb

- The mud squished under my shoes.
- Strawberries so ripe that they squished if picked too firmly.
- Naomi was furiously squishing her ice cream in her bowl.
