aboveground	On or above the surface of the ground. <i>Aboveground nuclear testing.</i>
absentee	One that is absent or not in residence. <i>An absentee from the match.</i>
absenteeism	The practice of regularly staying away from work or school without good reason. <i>High levels of absenteeism caused by low job motivation.</i>
away	Out of the way especially away from one s thoughts. <i>Ran away from the lion.</i>
bonus	Anything that tends to arouse. <i>Big Christmas bonuses.</i>
by	So as to pass a given point. <i>He let only a moment go by.</i>
dividend	An individual s share of a dividend. <i>Buying a rail pass may still pay dividends.</i>
exclude	Prevent from being included or considered or accepted. <i>Clauses seeking to exclude liability for loss or damage.</i>
exhale	Expel air. <i>The jungle exhaled mists of early morning.</i>
harpoon	Spear with a harpoon. <i>Gilbert s father harpooned a five metre basking shark.</i>
home	Provide an animal with a home as a pet. <i>A teaching style which homes in on what is of central importance for each pupil.</i>
impale	Display (a coat of arms) side by side with another on the same shield, separated by a vertical line. <i>The enemies were impaled and left to die.</i>

invest	Make an investment. <i>He stands before you invested in the full canonicals of his calling.</i>
lance	Pierce with or as if with a lance. <i>Lance a boil.</i>
omit	Leave undone or leave out. <i>He modestly omits to mention that he was a pole vault champion.</i>
payment	Something given as a reward or in recompense for something done. <i>A compensation payment of 2500.</i>
pinch	Make ridges into by pinching together. <i>Pinch out tips of shoots regularly.</i>
porcupine	A large rodent with defensive spines or quills on the body and tail.
prickle	Cause a stinging or tingling sensation. <i>I hate the way the fibres prickle your skin.</i>
protrude	Of an animal cause a body part to protrude. <i>When attacking it protrudes its long snout.</i>
respire	Undergo the biomedical and metabolic processes of respiration by taking up oxygen and producing carbon monoxide. <i>A country where fresh air seems impossible to respire.</i>
shareholder	An owner of shares in a company.
spear	Pierce with a spear. <i>She speared her last chip with her fork.</i>
spike	Render a gun useless by plugging up the vent with a spike. <i>The plutonium mixture could be spiked with caesium 137.</i>
spindle	A Eurasian shrub or small tree with slender toothed leaves and pink capsules containing bright orange seeds Its hard timber was formerly used for making spindles. <i>Chromosomes are distributed by spindles in mitosis and meiosis.</i>
spiny	Having spines. <i>A spiny cactus.</i>
stick	Come or be in close contact with stick or hold together and resist separation. <i>Training that relies more on the carrot than on the stick.</i>
sticker	An adhesive label. <i>A disabled sticker for our car.</i>
thorn	A thorny bush shrub or tree especially a hawthorn. <i>He s a thorn in my flesh.</i>
