
Stalker as a Noun

Definitions of "Stalker" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "stalker" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- Someone who prowls or sneaks about; usually with unlawful intentions.
- Someone who stalks game.
- Someone who walks with long stiff strides.
- A person who harasses or persecutes someone with unwanted and obsessive attention.
- A person who hunts game stealthily.





Synonyms of "Stalker" as a noun (2 Words)

sneak Someone who prowls or sneaks about usually with unlawful intentions. *Ethel was the form* **sneak** *and goody goody.*
