Stalker as a Noun

Definitions of "Stalker" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “stalker” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Someone who prowls or sneaks about; usually with unlawful intentions.*
- *Someone who stalks game.*
- *Someone who walks with long stiff strides.*
- *A person who harasses or persecutes someone with unwanted and obsessive attention.*
- *A person who hunts game stealthily.*



Synonyms of "Stalker" as a noun (2 Words)

prowler A person who moves stealthily about or loiters near a place with a view to committing a crime.

sneak Someone who prowls or sneaks about usually with unlawful intentions.
*Ethel was the form **sneak** and goody goody.*



Usage Examples of "Stalker" as a noun

- *Tracy claimed she was the victim of a stalker.*
- *An anonymous stalker sent her hate mail.*
- *A stalker of moose.*
- *A keen fisherman and deer stalker.*
