

<u>miracle</u>	A remarkable event or development that brings very welcome consequences. It was a <b>miracle</b> that more people hadn t been killed.
nonpareil	Model of excellence or perfection of a kind; one having no equal. A great player Britain s <b>nonpareil</b> of the 1980s.
prodigy	A sign of something about to happen. Germany seemed a <b>prodigy</b> of industrial discipline.
<u>rarity</u>	The state or quality of being rare. <i>To take the morning off was a <b>rarity</b>.</i>
<u>sensation</u>	The capacity to have physical sensations. She was a <b>sensation</b> the talk of the evening.
