- miracle** A remarkable event or development that brings very welcome consequences.
*It was a **miracle** that more people hadn't been killed.*
- nonpareil** Model of excellence or perfection of a kind; one having no equal.
*A great player Britain's **nonpareil** of the 1980s.*
- prodigy** A sign of something about to happen.
*Germany seemed a **prodigy** of industrial discipline.*
- rarity** The state or quality of being rare.
*To take the morning off was a **rarity**.*
- sensation** The capacity to have physical sensations.
*She was a **sensation** the talk of the evening.*

spectacle A blunder that makes you look ridiculous used in the phrase make a spectacle of yourself.

*The show is pure **spectacle**.*

wonder Something that causes feelings of wonder.

*Have you ever explored the **wonders** of a coral reef.*
