

A remarkable event or development that brings very welcome consequences. **miracle**

It was a **miracle** that more people hadn t been killed.

nonpareil Model of excellence or perfection of a kind; one having no equal.

A great player Britain s nonpareil of the 1980s.

A sign of something about to happen. prodigy Germany seemed a **prodigy** of industrial discipline.

The state or quality of being rare. rarity To take the morning off was a rarity.

The capacity to have physical sensations. **sensation** She was a **sensation** the talk of the evening.



A blunder that makes you look ridiculous used in the phrase make a spectacle of spectacle yourself.

The show is pure **spectacle**.

Something that causes feelings of wonder.

wonder Have you ever explored the **wonder**s of a coral reef.
