## Statue as a Noun

### Definitions of "Statue" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “statue” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A carved or cast figure of a person or animal, especially one that is life-size or larger.*
- *A sculpture representing a human or animal.*



## Synonyms of "Statue" as a noun (6 Words)

- effigy** A representation of a person (especially in the form of sculpture).  
*A tomb **effigy** of Eleanor of Aquitaine.*
- figure** A shape which is defined by one or more lines in two dimensions (such as a circle or a triangle), or one or more surfaces in three dimensions (such as a sphere or a cuboid), either considered mathematically in geometry or used as a decorative design.  
*By 1998 this **figure** had risen to 14 million.*
- figurine** A statuette, especially one of a human form.
- idol** A person or thing that is greatly admired, loved, or revered.  
*A soccer **idol**.*

**sculpture** A work of art made by sculpture.  
*The boundary between painting and **sculpture** is displaced.*

**statuette** A small carved or molded figure.



## Associations of "Statue" (30 Words)

**alabaster** Of or resembling alabaster.  
***Alabaster** statue.*

**anniversary** The date on which a romance began in a previous month or week.  
*The 75th **anniversary** of the RAF.*

**carve** Produce (an object, inscription, or design) by cutting into a hard material.  
*I **carved** my initials on the tree.*

**caryatid** A supporting column carved in the shape of a person.

**celebration** The action of celebrating an important day or event.  
*A birthday **celebration**.*

**commemorate** Recall and show respect for (someone or something).  
*This sculpture **commemorates** the victims of the concentration camps.*

<b>effigy</b>	A roughly made model of a person that is made in order to be damaged or destroyed as a protest. <i>The coin bears an <b>effigy</b> of Lincoln.</i>
<b>engrave</b>	Cut (a design) as lines on a metal plate for printing. <i><b>Engrave</b> a letter.</i>
<b>epigraph</b>	A short quotation or saying at the beginning of a book or chapter, intended to suggest its theme.
<b>etch</b>	The action or process of etching something. <i>The outline of the town was <b>etched</b> against the sky.</i>
<b>gargoyle</b>	An ornament consisting of a grotesquely carved figure of a person or animal.
<b>inscription</b>	A short message (as in a book or musical work or on a photograph) dedicating it to someone or something. <i>The <b>inscription</b> on her headstone.</i>
<b>marble</b>	Used figuratively to refer to something with the smoothness hardness or colour of marble. <i>A pair of dramatic <b>marbles</b> showing dogs attacking a buck.</i>
<b>memorial</b>	A written statement of facts submitted in conjunction with a petition to an authority. <i>A <b>memorial</b> to General Robert E Lee.</i>
<b>memorialize</b>	Preserve the memory of; commemorate. <i>The President <b>memorialized</b> the heroes of the battle.</i>
<b>molding</b>	Sculpture produced by molding.
<b>monument</b>	An enduring and memorable example of something. <i>Recordings that are a <b>monument</b> to the art of playing the piano.</i>
<b>monumental</b>	Of or serving as a monument. <i>Einstein's <b>monumental</b> contributions to physics.</i>
<b>plaque</b>	A small, distinct, typically raised patch or region on or within the body resulting from local damage or deposition of material, such as a fatty deposit on an artery wall in atherosclerosis or a site of localized damage of brain tissue in Alzheimer's disease. <i><b>Plaque</b> around gum margins can lead to gingivitis.</i>
<b>sculpt</b>	Create by shaping stone or wood or any other hard material. <i><b>Sculpt</b> a swan out of a block of ice.</i>
<b>sculpture</b>	A work of art made by sculpture. <i>A collection of <b>sculpture</b>.</i>
<b>slab</b>	Remove slabs from a log or tree to prepare it for sawing into planks. <i>A <b>slab</b> of bread and cheese.</i>

<b>statuary</b>	A sculptor. <i>Classical <b>statuary</b>.</i>
<b>statuesque</b>	(of a woman) attractively tall, graceful, and dignified. <i>Her <b>statuesque</b> beauty.</i>
<a href="#"><u>stone</u></a>	A piece of stone shaped for a purpose especially one of commemoration ceremony or demarcation. <i>Boundary <b>stones</b>.</i>
<b>tercentenary</b>	The three-hundredth anniversary of a significant event. <i>His <b>tercentenary</b> year.</i>
<a href="#"><u>tomb</u></a>	A place for the burial of a corpse especially beneath the ground and marked by a tombstone. <i>The house was as quiet as a <b>tomb</b>.</i>
<b>triennial</b>	Lasting for or relating to a period of three years. <i>The <b>triennial</b> meeting of the Association.</i>
<b>vandalism</b>	Willful wanton and malicious destruction of the property of others. <i>Surveillance of the building would reduce <b>vandalism</b> and theft.</i>
<b>woodwork</b>	Work made of wood; especially moldings or stairways or furniture. <i>The <b>woodwork</b> was painted blue.</i>
