Infinitive	<b>to stean</b>
Present Tense	<b>stean / steans</b>
Past Tense	<b>steaned</b>
Present Participle	<b>steaning</b>
Past Participle	<b>steaned</b>

## Conjugate Stean

**Stean in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>steal</b>	We <b>steal</b>
You <b>steal</b>	You <b>steal</b>
He/She/It <b>steals</b>	They <b>steal</b>

## **Steal in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am stealing</b>	We <b>are stealing</b>
You <b>are stealing</b>	You <b>are stealing</b>
He/She/It <b>is stealing</b>	They <b>are stealing</b>

## **Steal in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have stolen</b>	We <b>have stolen</b>
You <b>have stolen</b>	You <b>have stolen</b>
He/She/It <b>has stolen</b>	They <b>have stolen</b>

## **Steal in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been stealing</b>	We <b>have been stealing</b>
You <b>have been stealing</b>	You <b>have been stealing</b>
He/She/It <b>has been stealing</b>	They <b>have been stealing</b>

## **Steal in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>stole</b>	We <b>stole</b>
You <b>stole</b>	You <b>stole</b>
He/She/It <b>stole</b>	They <b>stole</b>

## **Steal in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>was steaning</b>	We <b>were steaning</b>
You <b>were steaning</b>	You <b>were steaning</b>
He/She/It <b>was steaning</b>	They <b>were steaning</b>

**Stean in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>had steaned</b>	We <b>had steaned</b>
You <b>had steaned</b>	You <b>had steaned</b>
He/She/It <b>had steaned</b>	They <b>had steaned</b>

**Stean in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I <b>had been steaning</b>	We <b>had been steaning</b>
You <b>had been steaning</b>	You <b>had been steaning</b>
He/She/It <b>had been steaning</b>	They <b>had been steaning</b>

**Stean in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I <b>will stean</b>	We <b>will stean</b>
You <b>will stean</b>	You <b>will stean</b>
He/She/It <b>will stean</b>	They <b>will stean</b>

**Stean in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I <b>will be steaning</b>	We <b>will be steaning</b>
You <b>will be steaning</b>	You <b>will be steaning</b>
He/She/It <b>will be steaning</b>	They <b>will be steaning</b>

**Stean in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have steaned**

**We will have steaned**

**You will have steaned**

**You will have steaned**

**He/She/It will have steaned**

**They will have steaned**

**Steane in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been steaneing**

**We will have been steaneing**

**You will have been steaneing**

**You will have been steaneing**

**He/She/It will have been steaneing**

**They will have been steaneing**
