## The Forms of Step

Infinitive	<b>to step</b>
Present Tense	<b>step / steps</b>
Past Tense	<b>stepped, stept ( dated ) , or stope ( obsolete )</b>
Present Participle	<b>stepping</b>
Past Participle	<b>stepped, stept, or stopen</b>

## Conjugate Step

### Step in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

**Singular      Plural**

I **step**                      We **step**  
You **step**                  You **step**  
He/She/It **steps**      They **step**

## **Step in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular                      Plural**

I **am stepping**              We **are stepping**  
You **are stepping**          You **are stepping**  
He/She/It **is stepping**      They **are stepping**

## **Step in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have stepped, stept, or stopen**              We **have stepped, stept, or stopen**  
You **have stepped, stept, or stopen**          You **have stepped, stept, or stopen**  
He/She/It **has stepped, stept, or stopen**      They **have stepped, stept, or stopen**

## **Step in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been stepping**              We **have been stepping**  
You **have been stepping**          You **have been stepping**  
He/She/It **has been stepping**      They **have been stepping**

## **Step in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **stepped, stept ( dated ) , or stope ( obsolete )**              We **stepped, stept ( dated ) , or stope ( obsolete )**  
You **stepped, stept ( dated ) , or stope ( obsolete )**          You **stepped, stept ( dated ) , or stope ( obsolete )**  
He/She/It **stepped, stept ( dated ) , or stope ( obsolete )**      They **stepped, stept ( dated ) , or stope ( obsolete )**

## Step in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

### Singular

### Plural

I **was stepping**

We **were stepping**

You **were stepping**

You **were stepping**

He/She/It **was stepping**

They **were stepping**

## Step in Past Perfect Tense

### Singular

### Plural

I **had stepped, stept, or stopen**

We **had stepped, stept, or stopen**

You **had stepped, stept, or stopen**

You **had stepped, stept, or stopen**

He/She/It **had stepped, stept, or stopen**

They **had stepped, stept, or stopen**

## Step in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

### Singular

### Plural

I **had been stepping**

We **had been stepping**

You **had been stepping**

You **had been stepping**

He/She/It **had been stepping**

They **had been stepping**

## Step in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

### Singular

### Plural

I **will step**

We **will step**

You **will step**

You **will step**

He/She/It **will step**

They **will step**

## Step in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

### Singular

### Plural

I **will be stepping**

We **will be stepping**

You **will be stepping**

You **will be stepping**

He/She/It **will be stepping**

They **will be stepping**

## Step in Future Perfect Tense

### Singular

### Plural

**I will have stepped, stept, or stopen**

**We will have stepped, stept, or stopen**

**You will have stepped, stept, or stopen**

**You will have stepped, stept, or stopen**

**He/She/It will have stepped, stept, or stopen**

**They will have stepped, stept, or stopen**

## Step in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

### Singular

### Plural

**I will have been stepping**

**We will have been stepping**

**You will have been stepping**

**You will have been stepping**

**He/She/It will have been stepping**

**They will have been stepping**
