| advancement | The act of moving forward (as toward a goal). <i>Their lives were devoted to the advancement of science.</i> |
| alabaster | Of or resembling alabaster. <i>Alabaster statue.</i> |
| boulder | A large rock, typically one that has been worn smooth by erosion. |
| caryatid | A supporting column carved in the shape of a person. |
| cavern | Hollow out as if making a cavern. <i>His eyes were dark caverns.</i> |
| commemorative | Intended as a commemoration. <i>A commemorative plaque.</i> |
| forwarding | The act of sending on to another destination. <i>A freight forwarding company.</i> |
| gypsum | A common white or colorless mineral (hydrated calcium sulphate) used to make cements and plasters (especially plaster of Paris). |
| homogenization | The process of making things uniform or similar. <i>The homogenization of cream.</i> |
| limestone | A hard sedimentary rock, composed mainly of calcium carbonate or dolomite, used as building material and in the making of cement. |
| marble | A marble sculpture. <i>A marble floor.</i> |
| memorial | A statement of facts, especially as the basis of a petition. <i>The Council sent a strongly worded memorial to the Chancellor of the Exchequer.</i> |
| mineral | Of or denoting a mineral. <i>The economy has long been dependent on exports of minerals especially gold.</i> |

| monument | A statue or other structure placed over a grave in memory of the dead. <i>A handsome monument of granite is placed over the grave.</i> |
| obelisk | A mountain tree or other natural object resembling an obelisk in shape. |
| plaque | A flat counter used in gambling. <i>Plaque around gum margins can lead to gingivitis.</i> |
| porphyry | Any igneous rock with crystals embedded in a finer groundmass of minerals. |
| procedure | A mode of conducting legal and parliamentary proceedings. <i>The standard procedure for informing new employees about conditions of work.</i> |
| proceed | Follow a procedure or take a course. <i>My studies are proceeding well.</i> |
| progress | Cause a task or undertaking to make progress. <i>Work on the pond is progressing.</i> |
| progression | A number of things in a series. <i>A steady progression towards your goals.</i> |
| promotion | Encouragement of the progress or growth or acceptance of something. <i>United won promotion last season.</i> |
| protocol | The accepted or established code of procedure or behaviour in any group, organization, or situation. <i>Safety protocols.</i> |
| rock | A large piece of rock which has become detached from a cliff or mountain a boulder. <i>The police discovered six ounces of rock in his van.</i> |
| sandstone | A sedimentary rock consisting of sand consolidated with some cement (clay or quartz etc). |
| sculpt | Create by shaping stone or wood or any other hard material. <i>Sculpting human figures from ivory.</i> |
| sculpture | Form or shape as if by sculpture especially with strong smooth curves. <i>Ammonite shells with external sculpture near the aperture.</i> |
| slate | A flat plate of slate formerly used for writing on in schools. <i>The company has revealed details of a 60m slate of film productions.</i> |
| stalagmite | A mound or tapering column rising from the floor of a cave, formed of calcium salts deposited by dripping water and often uniting with a stalactite. |

totem

A clan or tribe identified by their kinship to a common totemic object.
*Other radical groups look to the party as a **totem** of the anti austerity movement.*
