Conjugate Stereotype

Stereotype in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I **stereotype**You **stereotype**He/She/It **stereotypes**They **stereotype**

Stereotype in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am stereotyping We are stereotyping
You are stereotyping You are stereotyping
He/She/It is stereotyping They are stereotyping

Stereotype in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have stereotyped We have stereotyped
You have stereotyped You have stereotyped
He/She/It has stereotyped They have stereotyped

Stereotype in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been stereotyping
You have been stereotyping
He/She/It has been stereotyping
They have been stereotyping

Stereotype in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **stereotyped** We **stereotyped**You **stereotyped** You **stereotyped**He/She/It **stereotyped** They **stereotyped**

Stereotype in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was stereotyping We were stereotyping
You were stereotyping You were stereotyping
He/She/It was stereotyping They were stereotyping

Stereotype in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had stereotyped We had stereotyped
You had stereotyped You had stereotyped
He/She/It had stereotyped They had stereotyped

Stereotype in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been stereotyping
You had been stereotyping
He/She/It had been stereotyping
They had been stereotyping

Stereotype in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will stereotype
You will stereotype
He/She/It will stereotype
They will stereotype

Stereotype in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be stereotyping
You will be stereotyping
He/She/It will be stereotyping
They will be stereotyping

Stereotype in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have stereotyped We will have stereotyped You will have stereotyped You will have stereotyped He/She/It will have stereotyped They will have stereotyped

Stereotype in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been stereotyping
You will have been stereotyping
He/She/It will have been stereotyping
They will have been stereotyping
