Past Tense	stipendiated
Present Participle	stipendiating
Past Participle	stipendiated

Conjugate Stipendiate

Stipendiate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I stipendiate	We stipendiate
You stipendiate	You stipendiate
He/She/It stipendiates	They stipendiate

Stipendiate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am stipendiating	We are stipendiating
You are stipendiating	You are stipendiating
He/She/It is stipendiating	They are stipendiating

Stipendiate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have stipendiated	We have stipendiated
You have stipendiated	You have stipendiated
He/She/It has stipendiated	They have stipendiated

Stipendiate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been stipendiating	We have been stipendiating
You have been stipendiating	You have been stipendiating
He/She/It has been stipendiating	They have been stipendiating

Stipendiate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I stipendiated	We stipendiated
You stipendiated	You stipendiated
He/She/It stipendiated	They stipendiated

Stipendiate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was stipendiating	We were stipendiating
You were stipendiating	You were stipendiating
He/She/It was stipendiating	They were stipendiating

Stipendiate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had stipendiated	We had stipendiated
You had stipendiated	You had stipendiated
He/She/It had stipendiated	They had stipendiated

Stipendiate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been stipendiating	We had been stipendiating
You had been stipendiating	You had been stipendiating
He/She/It had been stipendiating	They had been stipendiating

Stipendiate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will stipendiate	We will stipendiate
You will stipendiate	You will stipendiate
He/She/It will stipendiate	They will stipendiate

Stipendiate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I will be stipendiating	We will be stipendiating
You will be stipendiating	You will be stipendiating
He/She/It will be stipendiating	They will be stipendiating
