Associations of "Stood out" (30 Words)

aboveground	On or above the surface of the ground. <i>Aboveground nuclear testing.</i>
athwart	So as to be perverse or contradictory. <i>Our words ran athwart and we ended up at cross purposes.</i>
away	Out of the way especially away from one's thoughts. <i>He's away right now.</i>
building	The occupants of a building. <i>There was a three story building on the corner.</i>
by	So as to go past. <i>A car flashed by on the other side of the road.</i>
construction	The commercial activity involved in repairing old structures or constructing new ones. <i>During the construction we had to take a detour.</i>
crossbeam	A horizontal beam that extends across something.
dais	A platform raised above the surrounding level to give prominence to the person on it.
exclude	Remove from consideration. <i>The bad results were excluded from the report.</i>
exhale	Breathe out. <i>He exhaled the smoke towards the ceiling.</i>
home	Return home accurately from a long distance. <i>Montana is home to a surprising number of rare mammals.</i>
lank	Of a person lanky. <i>He sprawled his long lank figure over a chair.</i>
outdoor	Pertaining to or concerning the outdoors or outdoor activities. <i>A rugged outdoor type.</i>

passage	A narrow way allowing access between buildings or to different rooms within a building a passageway. <i>The outward passage took 10 days.</i>
podium	Of a competitor in a sporting event finish first second or third so as to appear on a podium to receive an award. <i>He was at the podium facing an expectant conference crowd.</i>
pulpit	A raised enclosed platform in a church or chapel from which the preacher delivers a sermon. <i>Many ministers delivered political guidance from their pulpits.</i>
respire	Recover hope, courage, or strength after a time of difficulty. <i>Lichens respire at lower levels of temperature and moisture.</i>
rostrum	Beaklike projection of the anterior part of the head of certain insects such as e.g. weevils. <i>Speaker after speaker stepped up to the rostrum.</i>
shaft	Equip with a shaft. <i>The executives continue to raise their pay while the workers get the shaft.</i>
sideways	To, toward or at one side. <i>Take a sideways look at daily life.</i>
southbound	Moving toward the south. <i>Southbound traffic.</i>
spindly	Weak or insubstantial in construction. <i>Spindly chairs.</i>
standing	Executed in or initiated from a standing position. <i>They built the world's largest advertising agency from a standing start nineteen years ago.</i>
steel	Knife sharpener consisting of a ridged steel rod. <i>A steel will.</i>
straight	In a straight line directly. <i>A straight choice between nuclear power and penury.</i>
supine	Offering no resistance- Theodore Roosevelt. <i>The government was supine in the face of racial injustice.</i>
upright	Upright in position or posture. <i>Upright stone slabs.</i>
vertical	A vertical line or plane. <i>We need more vertical cooperation between manufacturers and service providers.</i>
