accusative	The accusative case. An accusative forefinger.
bluff	The act of bluffing in poker deception by a false show of confidence in the strength of your cards. <i>The object is to bluff your opponent into submission.</i>
direct	Give directions to point somebody into a certain direction. A direct descendant of Edward III.
directly	At once; immediately. I ll be back directly .
<u>firsthand</u>	Received directly from a source. <i>Firsthand</i> information.
immediately	Bearing an immediate relation. <i>He answered immediately.</i>
intuition	An impression that something might be the case. We shall allow our intuition to guide us.
intuitive	Spontaneously derived from or prompted by a natural tendency. <i>His intuitive understanding of the readers real needs.</i>
lank	Of a person lanky. Grown lank with fasting.
lineal	Relating to or consisting of lines; linear. A lineal descendant.
<u>linear</u>	Able to be represented by a straight line on a graph. <i>Linear</i> relationship.
lineation	The division of text into lines. <i>Magnetic lineations</i> .
<u>nonstop</u>	Without stopping. <i>How many nonstops are there to Dallas.</i>



orthogonal	Not pertinent to the matter under consideration. Wind and sea may displace the ship s center of gravity along three orthogonal axes.
precipitous	Done with very great haste and without due deliberation- Shakespeare- Arthur Geddes. A precipitous slide in the government s popularity.
prescriptive	Pertaining to giving directives or rules. A prescriptive grammar book.
rectilinear	Contained by, consisting of, or moving in a straight line or lines. The rectilinear propagation of light.
risen	(of e.g. celestial bodies) above the horizon. <i>The risen sun.</i>
<u>shortcut</u>	A route shorter than the usual one. They were taking a shortcut to town.
<u>soon</u>	Early. Everyone will soon know the truth.
spindly	Weak or insubstantial in construction. <i>Spindly chairs.</i>
straightness	Trueness of course toward a goal.
supine	Offering no resistance- Theodore Roosevelt. No other colony showed such supine selfish helplessness in allowing her own border citizens to be mercilessly harried.
<u>target</u>	The location of the target that is to be hit. The target of a manhunt.
<u>unilateral</u>	Relating to or affecting only one side of an organ, the body, or another structure. <i>A unilateral decision.</i>
upright	An upright piano. An upright vacuum cleaner.
<u>verbatim</u>	Using exactly the same words. Subjects were instructed to recall the passage verbatim .
vertical	Something that is oriented vertically. A column still vertical amid the ruins.
