### Definitions of "Stratification" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "stratification" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- The formation of strata in rock.
- The condition of being arranged in social strata or classes within a group.
- Forming or depositing in layers.
- The placing of seeds in damp sand or sawdust or peat moss in order to preserve them or promote germination.
- $\bullet \ \ The \ arrangement \ or \ classification \ of \ something \ into \ different \ groups.$
- The placing of seeds close together in layers in moist sand or peat to preserve them or to help them germinate.
- The act or process or arranging persons into classes or social strata.
- A layered configuration.
