Definitions of "Stratification" as a noun

- The formation of strata in rock.
- The condition of being arranged in social strata or classes within a group.
- Forming or depositing in layers.
- The placing of seeds in damp sand or sawdust or peat moss in order to preserve them or promote germination.
- The arrangement or classification of something into different groups.
- The placing of seeds close together in layers in moist sand or peat to preserve them or to help them germinate.
- The act or process or arranging persons into classes or social strata.
- A layered configuration.

social stratification A party of people assembled to promote sociability and communal activity.

- Following cold stratification, seeds were germinated in greenhouses.
