Infinitive to stretch

Past Tense straught (obsolete), straight (obsolete) or stretched

Present Participle **stretching**

Past Participle straught (obsolete), straight (obsolete) or stretched

Conjugate Stretch

Stretch in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I stretch We stretch
You stretch You stretch
He/She/It stretches They stretch

Stretch in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am stretching We are stretching
You are stretching You are stretching
He/She/It is stretching They are stretching

Stretch in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have straught (obsolete) , straight (obsolete) or stretched

You have straught (obsolete) , straight (obsolete) or stretched

You have straught (obsolete) , straight (obsolete) or stretched

He/She/It has straught (obsolete) , straight (obsolete) or stretched

They have straught (obsolete) , straight (obsolete) or stretched

Stretch in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been stretching
You have been stretching
He/She/It has been stretching
They have been stretching

Stretch in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I straught (obsolete) , straight (We straught (obsolete) , straight (obsolete) or stretched

You straught (obsolete) , straight (obsolete) or stretched

You straught (obsolete) , straight (obsolete) or stretched



Singular Plural

He/She/It straught (obsolete) , straight (They straught (obsolete) , straight (obsolete) or stretched obsolete) or stretched

Stretch in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I was stretching We were stretching
You were stretching You were stretching
He/She/It was stretching They were stretching

Stretch in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had straught (obsolete) , straight (We had straught (obsolete) , straight (

obsolete) or stretched obsolete) or stretched

You had straught (obsolete) , straight (You had straught (obsolete) , straight (

obsolete) or stretched obsolete) or stretched

He/She/It had straught (obsolete), They had straught (obsolete), straight

Stretch in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been stretching
You had been stretching
He/She/It had been stretching
They had been stretching

Stretch in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will stretch
You will stretch
He/She/It will stretch
They will stretch



Stretch in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be stretching
You will be stretching
He/She/It will be stretching
They will be stretching

Stretch in Future Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I will have straught (obsolete), straight (obsolete), straight (obsolete) or stretched

You will have straught (obsolete), straight (obsolete) or stretched

He/She/It will have straught (obsolete), straight (obsolete) or stretched

They will have straught (obsolete), straight (obsolete) or stretched

Stretch in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been stretching
You will have been stretching
He/She/It will have been stretching
They will have been stretching
