# **Conjugate Stridulate**

## Stridulate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>stridulate</b>	We <b>stridulate</b>
You <b>stridulate</b>	You <b>stridulate</b>
He/She/It <b>stridulates</b>	They <b>stridulate</b>

## **Stridulate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am stridulating	We <b>are stridulating</b>
You <b>are stridulating</b>	You <b>are stridulating</b>
He/She/It is stridulating	They are stridulating

## **Stridulate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have stridulated	We have stridulated
You have stridulated	You have stridulated
He/She/It has stridulated	They have stridulated

## **Stridulate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been stridulating	We have been stridulating
You <b>have been stridulating</b>	You have been stridulating
He/She/It has been stridulating	They have been stridulating

## Stridulate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I stridulated	We <b>stridulated</b>
You <b>stridulated</b>	You <b>stridulated</b>
He/She/It <b>stridulated</b>	They <b>stridulated</b>

## Stridulate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was stridulating	We were stridulating
You <b>were stridulating</b>	You were stridulating
He/She/It was stridulating	They were stridulating

## **Stridulate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had stridulated	We had stridulated
You had stridulated	You had stridulated
He/She/It had stridulated	They had stridulated

## **Stridulate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been stridulating	We <b>had been stridulating</b>
You <b>had been stridulating</b>	You <b>had been stridulating</b>
He/She/It had been stridulating They had been stridulating	

## Stridulate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will stridulate	We will stridulate
You <b>will stridulate</b>	You <b>will stridulate</b>
He/She/It will stridulate	They will stridulate

## **Stridulate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be stridulating	We will be stridulating
You <b>will be stridulating</b>	You will be stridulating
He/She/It will be stridulating	They will be stridulating
