The Forms of Strike

Infinitive to strike

Present Tense strike / strikes

Past Tense **struck**Present Participle **striking**

Past Participle struck or stricken

Strike in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Strike in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

SingularPluralI am strikingWe are strikingYou are strikingYou are strikingHe/She/It is strikingThey are striking

Strike in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have struck or stricken
You have struck or stricken
He/She/It has struck or stricken They have struck or stricken

Strike in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been striking We have been striking

You have been striking You have been striking

He/She/It has been striking They have been striking

Strike in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

SingularPluralI struckWe struckYou struckYou struckHe/She/It struckThey struck

Strike in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was striking We were striking
You were striking You were striking
He/She/It was striking They were striking

Strike in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had struck or stricken
You had struck or stricken
He/She/It had struck or stricken
They had struck or stricken

Strike in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been striking
You had been striking
He/She/It had been striking
They had been striking

Strike in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will strike
You will strike
He/She/It will strike
They will strike

Strike in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be striking We will be striking
You will be striking You will be striking
He/She/It will be striking They will be striking

Strike in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have struck or stricken
You will have struck or stricken
He/She/It will have struck or stricken
They will have struck or stricken

Strike in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been striking
You will have been striking
He/She/It will have been striking
They will have been striking
