# **Conjugate Stroke**

## Stroke in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>stroke</b>	We <b>stroke</b>
You <b>stroke</b>	You <b>stroke</b>
He/She/It strokes	They <b>stroke</b>

## Stroke in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am stroking	We <b>are stroking</b>
You <b>are stroking</b>	You <b>are stroking</b>
He/She/It is stroking	They are stroking

### **Stroke in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have stroked	We have stroked
You have stroked	You have stroked
He/She/It has stroked	They have stroked

### **Stroke in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been stroking	We have been stroking
You <b>have been stroking</b>	You <b>have been stroking</b>
He/She/It has been stroking	They have been stroking

# Stroke in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I stroked	We <b>stroked</b>
You <b>stroked</b>	You <b>stroked</b>
He/She/It <b>stroked</b>	They <b>stroked</b>

## Stroke in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was stroking	We were stroking
You were stroking	You were stroking
He/She/It was stroking	They were stroking

### **Stroke in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had stroked	We had stroked
You had stroked	You had stroked
He/She/It had stroked	They had stroked

## **Stroke in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been stroking	We had been stroking
You <b>had been stroking</b>	You had been stroking
He/She/It had been stroking	They had been stroking

# Stroke in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will stroke	We <b>will stroke</b>
You <b>will stroke</b>	You <b>will stroke</b>
He/She/It will stroke	They will stroke

# Stroke in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be stroking	We <b>will be stroking</b>
You <b>will be stroking</b>	You <b>will be stroking</b>
He/She/It will be stroking	They will be stroking

### **Stroke in Future Perfect Tense**

### **Stroke in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been stroking	We <b>will have been stroking</b>
You <b>will have been stroking</b>	You <b>will have been stroking</b>
He/She/It will have been stroking	They will have been stroking
