Associations of "Strung out meaning" (30 Words)

connotation	The abstract meaning or intension of a term, which forms a principle determining which objects or concepts it applies to. <i>The work functions both by analogy and by connotation.</i>
context	The set of facts or circumstances that surround a situation or event. <i>The proposals need to be considered in the context of new European directives.</i>
cryptic	Of an obscure nature. <i>Cryptic plumage is thought to minimize predation.</i>
dah	The longer of the two telegraphic signals used in Morse code.
decipher	Convert code into ordinary language. <i>Visual signals help us decipher what is being communicated.</i>
denotation	The act of indicating or pointing out by name. <i>Beyond their immediate denotation the words have a connotative power.</i>
egyptian	Of or relating to or characteristic of Egypt or its people or their language.
endearment	Love or affection. <i>A term of endearment.</i>
entail	A property bequeathed under an entail. <i>A situation which entails considerable risks.</i>
exclude	Prevent from entering; shut out. <i>One cannot exclude the possibility of a fall in house prices.</i>
exhale	Breathe out. <i>The chimney exhales a thick smoke.</i>
extrinsic	Not forming an essential part of a thing or arising or originating from the outside. <i>A complex interplay of extrinsic and intrinsic factors.</i>
figurative	Departing from a literal use of words; metaphorical. <i>The figurative art of the humanistic tradition.</i>

glyph	A hieroglyphic character or symbol. <i>Flanges painted with esoteric glyphs.</i>
hieroglyph	Writing that resembles hieroglyphics usually by being illegible. <i>Hieroglyphs describing the Mayan calendar.</i>
home	At or to or in the direction of one's home or family. <i>The growth in home ownership.</i>
<u>import</u>	Sales of imported goods or services or the revenue from such sales. <i>The lead role was played by an import from Sweden.</i>
indication	Something (as a course of action) that is indicated as expedient or necessary. <i>An indication of foul play.</i>
<u>interpret</u>	Give an interpretation or rendition of. <i>The evidence is difficult to interpret.</i>
literally	Used for emphasis while not being literally true. <i>The driver took it literally when asked to go straight over the roundabout.</i>
metaphorical	Expressing one thing in terms normally denoting another. <i>Many of our metaphorical expressions develop from our perceptions of the body.</i>
oracular	Holding or claiming the authority of an oracle. <i>The oracular sayings of Victorian poets.</i>
<u>outside</u>	Leading to or from the outside. <i>An outside chance.</i>
parenthesis	An interlude or interval. <i>In a challenging parenthesis Wordsworth comments on the evil effects of contemporary developments.</i>
<u>semantic</u>	Of or relating to meaning or the study of meaning.
significance	The quality of being worthy of attention; importance. <i>Do not underestimate the significance of nuclear power.</i>
similarity	A similar feature or aspect. <i>The similarity of symptoms makes them hard to diagnose.</i>
synonymous	Meaning the same or nearly the same. <i>His deeds had made his name synonymous with victory.</i>
term	Name formally or designate with a term. <i>Term starts tomorrow.</i>
<u>text</u>	Send someone a text message. <i>The preacher chose a text from Psalms to introduce his sermon.</i>
