Past Tense	<b>studied</b>
Present Participle	<b>studying</b>
Past Participle	<b>studied</b>

## Conjugate Study

**Study in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>study</b>	We <b>study</b>
You <b>study</b>	You <b>study</b>
He/She/It <b>studies</b>	They <b>study</b>

## **Study in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am studying</b>	We <b>are studying</b>
You <b>are studying</b>	You <b>are studying</b>
He/She/It <b>is studying</b>	They <b>are studying</b>

## **Study in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have studied</b>	We <b>have studied</b>
You <b>have studied</b>	You <b>have studied</b>
He/She/It <b>has studied</b>	They <b>have studied</b>

## **Study in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been studying</b>	We <b>have been studying</b>
You <b>have been studying</b>	You <b>have been studying</b>
He/She/It <b>has been studying</b>	They <b>have been studying</b>

## **Study in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>studied</b>	We <b>studied</b>
You <b>studied</b>	You <b>studied</b>
He/She/It <b>studied</b>	They <b>studied</b>

## **Study in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

<b>I was studying</b>	<b>We were studying</b>
<b>You were studying</b>	<b>You were studying</b>
<b>He/She/It was studying</b>	<b>They were studying</b>

**Study in Past Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had studied</b>	<b>We had studied</b>
<b>You had studied</b>	<b>You had studied</b>
<b>He/She/It had studied</b>	<b>They had studied</b>

**Study in Past Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had been studying</b>	<b>We had been studying</b>
<b>You had been studying</b>	<b>You had been studying</b>
<b>He/She/It had been studying</b>	<b>They had been studying</b>

**Study in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will study</b>	<b>We will study</b>
<b>You will study</b>	<b>You will study</b>
<b>He/She/It will study</b>	<b>They will study</b>

**Study in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will be studying</b>	<b>We will be studying</b>
<b>You will be studying</b>	<b>You will be studying</b>
<b>He/She/It will be studying</b>	<b>They will be studying</b>

**We will have been studying**

**You will have been studying**

**You will have been studying**

**He/She/It will have been studying**

**They will have been studying**
