- debonair** Having a cheerful, lively, and self-confident air- Frances G. Patton-  
H.M.Reynolds.  
*Life that is gay brisk and **debonair**.*
- debonaire** Having a cheerful, lively, and self-confident air.
- debonnaire** Having a sophisticated charm.
- dignified** Having or showing self-esteem.  
*She maintained a **dignified** silence.*

<b><u>gallant</u></b>	Having or displaying great dignity or nobility. <i>A <b>gallant</b> warrior.</i>
<b>gentlemanly</b>	Befitting a gentleman. <i>A <b>gentlemanly</b> profession.</i>
<b><u>poised</u></b>	Having a graceful and elegant bearing. <i>She had learnt from the girls at the salon how to appear perfectly <b>poised</b>.</i>
<b><u>polished</u></b>	(of grains especially rice) having the husk or outer layers removed. <i>His <b>polished</b> performance in the film.</i>
<b>politic</b>	Smoothly agreeable and courteous with a degree of sophistication. <i>I did not think it <b>politic</b> to express my reservations.</i>
<b><u>refined</u></b>	Showing a high degree of refinement and the assurance that comes from wide social experience. <i><b>Refined</b> sugar.</i>
<b>self-possessed</b>	In full control of your faculties.
<b><u>smooth</u></b>	Smoothly agreeable and courteous with a degree of sophistication. <i>Graphics are excellent with fast <b>smooth</b> scrolling.</i>
<b><u>sophisticated</u></b>	Appealing to or frequented by people who are sophisticated. <i>A chic <b>sophisticated</b> woman.</i>
<b>urbane</b>	Showing a high degree of refinement and the assurance that comes from wide social experience. <i><b>Urbane</b> wit was the mark of taste and cultivation.</i>
<b><u>worldly</u></b>	Characteristic of or devoted to the temporal world as opposed to the spiritual world. <i>His ambitions for <b>worldly</b> success.</i>
<b>worldly-wise</b>	Experienced in and wise to the ways of the world.

<b>beautiful</b>	Highly enjoyable. <i>Beautiful</i> poetry.
<b>beauty</b>	A combination of qualities that pleases the intellect. <i>She was considered a great beauty in her youth.</i>
<b>belle</b>	A young woman who is the most charming and beautiful of several rivals. <i>She was the belle of the ball.</i>
<b><u>charm</u></b>	Protect through supernatural powers or charms. <i>His charm has captivated the media.</i>
<b><u>charming</u></b>	Possessing or using or characteristic of or appropriate to supernatural powers- Shakespeare. <i>A charming country cottage.</i>
<b>comeliness</b>	The quality of being good looking and attractive.
<b>cultivated</b>	No longer in the natural state; developed by human care and for human use. <i>Cultivated</i> roses.
<b>cultured</b>	Characterized by refined taste and manners and good education. <i>A cultured and intelligent man.</i>
<b>debonair</b>	Having a cheerful, lively, and self-confident air. <i>Life that is gay brisk and debonair.</i>
<b>decency</b>	The quality of conforming to standards of propriety and morality. <i>She had the decency to come and confess.</i>
<b>elegance</b>	The quality of being pleasingly ingenious and simple; neatness. <i>A slender woman with grace and elegance.</i>
<b>enchantingly</b>	In a bewitching manner.
<b>foppish</b>	Affecting extreme elegance in dress and manner. <i>He is foppish and vain.</i>
<b>gentility</b>	Social superiority as demonstrated by polite and respectable manners, behaviour, or appearances. <i>Her grandmother's pretensions to gentility.</i>
<b>gentleman</b>	A manservant who acts as a personal attendant to his employer. <i>He behaved throughout like a perfect gentleman.</i>

<b>gracefully</b>	In a gracious or graceful manner. <i>He has aged <b>gracefully</b>.</i>
<b>gracefulness</b>	Beautiful carriage.
<b>gracious</b>	(in Christian belief) showing divine grace. <i><b>Gracious</b> even to unexpected visitors.</i>
<b>graciously</b>	In a courteous, kind, and pleasant manner. <i>He smiled <b>graciously</b>.</i>
<b>jaunty</b>	Having a cheerful, lively, and self-confident air- Frances G. Patton- H.M.Reynolds. <i>Walked with a <b>jaunty</b> step.</i>
<b>mincing</b>	Affectedly dainty or refined. <i>I don t have to go through the rest of my life with that <b>mincing</b> voice of yours.</i>
<b>nobleman</b>	A titled peer of the realm.
<b>poise</b>	Great coolness and composure under strain. <i><b>Poise</b> and good deportment can be cultivated.</i>
<b>politic</b>	Engage in political activity. <i>He was too <b>politic</b> to quarrel with so important a personage.</i>
<b>refined</b>	Showing a high degree of refinement and the assurance that comes from wide social experience. <i><b>Refined</b> people with <b>refined</b> taste.</i>
<b>sophisticated</b>	Appealing to or frequented by people who are sophisticated. <i>Discussion and reflection are necessary for a <b>sophisticated</b> response to a text.</i>
<b>sophistication</b>	The quality of being sophisticated. <i>Her air of <b>sophistication</b> and confidence.</i>
<b>svelte</b>	Showing a high degree of refinement and the assurance that comes from wide social experience. <i>She was <b>svelte</b> and sophisticated.</i>
<b>tasteful</b>	Free from what is tawdry or unbecoming. <i>A <b>tasteful</b> lounge bar.</i>
<b>urbane</b>	Showing a high degree of refinement and the assurance that comes from wide social experience. <i>The supposedly <b>urbane</b> restrained English gentleman.</i>
