| aggrandizement | The act of increasing the wealth or prestige or power or scope of something. <i>The aggrandizement of the king.</i> |
| aware | Concerned and well informed about a particular situation or development. <i>Aware that he had exceeded the speed limit.</i> |
| brawn | Physical strength in contrast to intelligence. <i>Pork brawn.</i> |
| capable | Have the skills and qualifications to do things well. <i>I m quite capable of taking care of myself.</i> |
| centralize | Bring (activities or processes) together in one place. <i>The Treasury centralized all naval refitting work at Devonport.</i> |
| clout | A long distance shot that hits a clout. <i>He clouted his attacker.</i> |
| dint | Interchangeable with `means' in the expression `by means of'. <i>The metal was dull and dinted.</i> |
| galvanic | Sudden and dramatic. <i>The new leader had a galvanic effect on morale.</i> |
| inertia | A tendency to do nothing or to remain unchanged. <i>The power required to overcome friction and the inertia of the moving parts.</i> |
| intangibility | The quality of being intangible and not perceptible by touch. |
| kilowatt | A measure of one thousand watts of electrical power. |
| might | Physical strength. <i>You might just call me Jane if you don t mind.</i> |
| miter | Fit together in a miter joint. <i>He covered the miter with glue before making the joint.</i> |

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| mogul | A bump on a ski slope. <i>The Hollywood movie mogul Sam Goldwyn.</i> |
| musculature | The system or arrangement of muscles in a body, part of the body, or an organ. <i>The shape and musculature of a dolphin.</i> |
| possibility | A possible alternative. <i>Relegation remains a distinct possibility.</i> |
| potential | Having or showing the capacity to develop into something in the future. <i>The potentials of the technology were never wholly controllable.</i> |
| potentiality | The inherent capacity for coming into being. <i>The technology is still relatively not well known in spite of its great potentiality.</i> |
| potentially | With a possibility of becoming actual. <i>Newly available oil might potentially create a drop in prices.</i> |
| prince | A close male relative of a monarch, especially a grandson. <i>Arctic char is a prince among fishes.</i> |
| puissance | A competitive test of a horse's ability to jump large obstacles in showjumping. <i>The puissance of the labor vote.</i> |
| recharge | Refill (a cup, glass, or other container) with liquid. <i>We recharged our glasses.</i> |
| sentience | The faculty through which the external world is apprehended. <i>Gave sentience to slugs and newts.</i> |
| sinew | The parts of a structure, system, or organization that give it strength or bind it together. <i>The sinews of government.</i> |
| spectral | Of or like a ghost. <i>Spectral emanations.</i> |
| spiritual | Lacking material body or form or substance. <i>Spiritual songs.</i> |
| substation | A subsidiary station where electricity is transformed for distribution by a low-voltage network. |
| superconductivity | The property of zero electrical resistance in some substances at very low absolute temperatures. |
| transcendent | Beyond or above the range of normal or physical human experience. <i>Her transcendent beauty.</i> |
