## Associations of "Subconsciously" (30 Words)

<b>aggrandizement</b>	The act of increasing the wealth or prestige or power or scope of something. <i>The <b>aggrandizement</b> of the king.</i>
<b>aware</b>	Concerned and well informed about a particular situation or development. <i><b>Aware</b> that he had exceeded the speed limit.</i>
<b>brawn</b>	Physical strength in contrast to intelligence. <i>Pork <b>brawn</b>.</i>
<a href="#">capable</a>	Have the skills and qualifications to do things well. <i>I m quite <b>capable</b> of taking care of myself.</i>
<b>centralize</b>	Bring (activities or processes) together in one place. <i>The Treasury <b>centralized</b> all naval refitting work at Devonport.</i>
<a href="#">clout</a>	A long distance shot that hits a clout. <i>He <b>clouted</b> his attacker.</i>
<b>dint</b>	Interchangeable with `means' in the expression `by means of'. <i>The metal was dull and <b>dinted</b>.</i>
<b>galvanic</b>	Sudden and dramatic. <i>The new leader had a <b>galvanic</b> effect on morale.</i>
<b>inertia</b>	A tendency to do nothing or to remain unchanged. <i>The power required to overcome friction and the <b>inertia</b> of the moving parts.</i>
<b>intangibility</b>	The quality of being intangible and not perceptible by touch.
<b>kilowatt</b>	A measure of one thousand watts of electrical power.
<a href="#">might</a>	Physical strength. <i>You <b>might</b> just call me Jane if you don t mind.</i>
<b>miter</b>	Fit together in a miter joint. <i>He covered the <b>miter</b> with glue before making the joint.</i>

<b>mogul</b>	A bump on a ski slope. <i>The Hollywood movie <b>mogul</b> Sam Goldwyn.</i>
<b>musculature</b>	The system or arrangement of muscles in a body, part of the body, or an organ. <i>The shape and <b>musculature</b> of a dolphin.</i>
<b>possibility</b>	A possible alternative. <i>Relegation remains a distinct <b>possibility</b>.</i>
<b>potential</b>	Having or showing the capacity to develop into something in the future. <i>The <b>potentials</b> of the technology were never wholly controllable.</i>
<b>potentiality</b>	The inherent capacity for coming into being. <i>The technology is still relatively not well known in spite of its great <b>potentiality</b>.</i>
<b>potentially</b>	With a possibility of becoming actual. <i>Newly available oil might <b>potentially</b> create a drop in prices.</i>
<b>prince</b>	A close male relative of a monarch, especially a grandson. <i>Arctic char is a <b>prince</b> among fishes.</i>
<b>puissance</b>	A competitive test of a horse's ability to jump large obstacles in showjumping. <i>The <b>puissance</b> of the labor vote.</i>
<b>recharge</b>	Refill (a cup, glass, or other container) with liquid. <i>We <b>recharged</b> our glasses.</i>
<b>sentience</b>	The faculty through which the external world is apprehended. <i>Gave <b>sentience</b> to slugs and newts.</i>
<b>sinew</b>	The parts of a structure, system, or organization that give it strength or bind it together. <i>The <b>sinews</b> of government.</i>
<b>spectral</b>	Of or like a ghost. <i><b>Spectral</b> emanations.</i>
<b>spiritual</b>	Lacking material body or form or substance. <i><b>Spiritual</b> songs.</i>
<b>substation</b>	A subsidiary station where electricity is transformed for distribution by a low-voltage network.
<b>superconductivity</b>	The property of zero electrical resistance in some substances at very low absolute temperatures.
<b>transcendent</b>	Beyond or above the range of normal or physical human experience. <i>Her <b>transcendent</b> beauty.</i>
