Associations of "Subject to" (30 Words)

accompanying	Following or accompanying as a consequence. <i>The accompanying documentation.</i>
accretion	The coming together and cohesion of matter under the influence of gravitation to form larger bodies. <i>The central city surrounded by recent accretions.</i>
aim	Have an ambitious plan or a lofty goal. <i>It was created with the conscious aim of answering immediate needs.</i>
archaeological	Related to or dealing with or devoted to archaeology. <i>An archaeological dig.</i>
blob	An indeterminate roundish mass or shape. <i>He made a string of blobs then hit a hundred.</i>
caption	Provide with a caption as of a photograph or a drawing. <i>The photograph was captioned Three little maids.</i>
communique	An official report (usually sent in haste).
contentious	Inclined or showing an inclination to dispute or disagree, even to engage in law suits. <i>A style described as abrasive and contentious.</i>
contents	A list of divisions (chapters or articles) and the pages on which they start. <i>He emptied the contents of his pockets.</i>
controversial	Marked by or capable of arousing controversy. <i>A controversial decision on affirmative action.</i>
controversy	A contentious speech act; a dispute where there is strong disagreement. <i>The announcement ended a protracted controversy.</i>
corporeal	Affecting or characteristic of the body as opposed to the mind or spirit. <i>He was frank about his corporeal appetites.</i>

crux	A small conspicuous constellation in the southern hemisphere in the Milky Way near Centaurus. <i>The crux of the matter is that attitudes have changed.</i>
<u>debatable</u>	Open to discussion or argument. <i>It is debatable whether the country is coming out of recession.</i>
hank	A coil or skein of wool, hair, or other material. <i>A thick hank of her blonde hair.</i>
heading	The direction or path along which something moves or along which it lies. <i>This topic falls under four main headings.</i>
issue	Prepare and issue for public distribution or sale. <i>The last issue of penicillin was over a month ago.</i>
item	Used to introduce each item in a list. <i>She had several items on her shopping list.</i>
keynote	Set the keynote of. <i>Individuality is the keynote of the Nineties.</i>
matter	Having consequence. <i>What did it matter to them.</i>
qualitatively	In a qualitative manner. <i>Our results differ qualitatively from previous studies.</i>
question	Ask someone questions especially in an official context. <i>There was a question about my training.</i>
reenact	Act out; represent or perform as if in a play. <i>Congress reenacted the law.</i>
referent	The thing in the world that a word or phrase denotes or stands for. <i>The Morning Star and the Evening Star have the same referent the planet Venus.</i>
stuff	Fill with a stuffing while cooking. <i>The trunk was full of stuff.</i>
<u>thematic</u>	Relating to or constituting a topic of discourse. <i>The book is organized into nine thematic chapters.</i>
theme	Give a particular theme or setting to a leisure venue event etc. <i>Love and honour are the pivotal themes of the Hornblower books.</i>
thing	Personal belongings or clothing. <i>Things are going well.</i>
topic	The subject matter of a conversation or discussion. <i>He kept drifting off the topic.</i>
