Present Tense	<b>subsecute / subsecutes</b>
Past Tense	<b>subsecuted</b>
Present Participle	<b>subsecuting</b>
Past Participle	<b>subsecuted</b>

**Subsecute in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **subsecute**                      We **subsecute**  
You **subsecute**                You **subsecute**  
He/She/It **subsecutes**    They **subsecute**

**Subsecute in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am subsecuting**            We **are subsecuting**  
You **are subsecuting**        You **are subsecuting**  
He/She/It **is subsecuting**    They **are subsecuting**

**Subsecute in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have subsecuted**            We **have subsecuted**  
You **have subsecuted**        You **have subsecuted**  
He/She/It **has subsecuted**    They **have subsecuted**

**Subsecute in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been subsecuting**        We **have been subsecuting**  
You **have been subsecuting**      You **have been subsecuting**  
He/She/It **has been subsecuting**    They **have been subsecuting**

**Subsecute in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I **subsecuted**                      We **subsecuted**  
You **subsecuted**                You **subsecuted**  
He/She/It **subsecuted**        They **subsecuted**

**Subsecute in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

I **was subsecuting**                      We **were subsecuting**  
You **were subsecuting**              You **were subsecuting**  
He/She/It **was subsecuting**      They **were subsecuting**

**Subsecute in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had subsecuted**                      We **had subsecuted**  
You **had subsecuted**                  You **had subsecuted**  
He/She/It **had subsecuted**      They **had subsecuted**

**Subsecute in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I **had been subsecuting**              We **had been subsecuting**  
You **had been subsecuting**          You **had been subsecuting**  
He/She/It **had been subsecuting**      They **had been subsecuting**

**Subsecute in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I **will subsecute**                      We **will subsecute**  
You **will subsecute**                  You **will subsecute**  
He/She/It **will subsecute**      They **will subsecute**

**Subsecute in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be subsecuting**                  We **will be subsecuting**  
You **will be subsecuting**              You **will be subsecuting**  
He/She/It **will be subsecuting**      They **will be subsecuting**

**Subsecute in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have subsecuted**

**We will have subsecuted**

**You will have subsecuted**

**You will have subsecuted**

**He/She/It will have subsecuted**

**They will have subsecuted**

**Subsecute in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**I will have been subsecuting**

**We will have been subsecuting**

**You will have been subsecuting**

**You will have been subsecuting**

**He/She/It will have been subsecuting**

**They will have been subsecuting**
