- Likely to have a disastrously damaging effect on oneself or one's interests.
- Deeply unhappy or depressed and likely to commit suicide.





Synonyms of "Suicidal" as an adjective (10 Words)

anguished Experiencing intense pain especially mental pain.

An **anguished** conscience.

desperate

Desperately determined.

A desperate sadness enveloped Ruth.

distressed Suffering from extreme anxiety, sorrow, or pain.

I was **distressed** at the news of his death.

grief-stricken Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.

heartbroken Suffering from overwhelming distress.

He was **heartbroken** at the thought of leaving the house.

hopeless Very bad or incompetent.

With a **hopeless** sigh he sat down.



in despair Directed or bound inward.

inconsolable Sad beyond comforting; incapable of being consoled.

His widow Jane was inconsolable.

self-destructive Dangerous to yourself or your interests.

sorrowing Sorrowful through loss or deprivation.

The **sorrowing** widower found it hard to relate to his sons.

- A suicidal career move.
- Two weeks later I was admitted for depression and suicidal tendencies.
- Far from being suicidal, he was clearly enjoying life.
- A suicidal corporate takeover strategy.
