Definitions of "Suite" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "suite" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- A musical composition of several movements only loosely connected.
- Apartment consisting of a series of connected rooms used as a living unit (as in a hotel.
- A group of minerals, rocks, or fossils occurring together and characteristic of a location or period.
- A set of rooms designated for one person's or family's use or for a particular purpose.
- A set of coordinating furniture.
- A set of selected pieces from an opera or musical, arranged to be played as one instrumental work.
- A set of programs with a uniform design and the ability to share data.
- A matching set of furniture.
- The group following and attending to some important person.
- A group of people in attendance on a monarch or other person of high rank.
- A set of instrumental compositions, originally in dance style, to be played in succession.

<u>apartment</u>	A suite of rooms usually on one floor of an apartment house. <i>The Imperial apartments.</i>
company	Small military unit; usually two or three platoons. He was silent among such distinguished company .
cortege	The group following and attending to some important person.
cortège	A funeral procession.
court	The courtiers retinue and household of a sovereign. <i>The house was built around an inner court.</i>
<u>entourage</u>	A group of people attending or surrounding an important person. An entourage of loyal courtiers.
following	What follows or comes next. <i>He attracted a worldwide following.</i>



retinue	A group of advisers, assistants, or others accompanying an important person. The rock star s retinue of security guards and personal cooks.
rooms	Apartment consisting of a series of connected rooms used as a living unit as in a hotel.
royal household	Stag with antlers of 12 or more branches.
set of rooms	Being temporarily ready to respond in a particular way.
<u>staff</u>	The body of teachers and administrators at a school. The dean addressed the letter to the entire staff of the university.
suite of rooms	A matching set of furniture.
<u>train</u>	A series of connected railway carriages or wagons moved by a locomotive or by integral motors. The bride s train was carried by her two young nephews.

- A suite of reception rooms.
- The Royal Saloon was built for the use of the Queen and her suite.
- Potassic rock suites are a characteristic feature of the area.
- There is plenty of space for a dining table and a three-piece suite.

draining	Having a debilitating effect.
faucet	A tap.
•	The instrumentalities (furniture and appliances and other movable accessories including curtains and rugs) that make a home (or other area) livable. A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious furnishing s.
<u>hotel</u>	A restaurant or cafe. A hotel room.
house	The management of a gambling house or casino. It could be that I just house d a massive burrito but I don t feel good.
<u>kitchen</u>	A set of fitments and units that are sold together and fixed in place in a kitchen. <i>Kitchen Swahili.</i>
lavatory	A room, building, or cubicle containing a toilet or toilets. <i>She flushed the lavatory.</i>
plumbing	The work of installing and maintaining a plumbing system. The kitchen has a gas cooker point and plumbing for an automatic washing machine.
restroom	A toilet in a public building.
<u>room</u>	A set of rooms typically rented in which a person couple or family live. <i>Hardly enough elbow room to turn around.</i>
sewer	Someone who sews. A sewer of fine gowns.



shower	Take a shower wash one s body in the shower. They installed a shower in the bathroom.
soap	A soap opera. She soap ed her face.
stool	Grow shoots in the form of stools or tillers. Fibre in the child s diet will soften the stool s.
taps	(military) signal to turn the lights out.
toilet	A room building or cubicle containing a toilet or toilets. A public toilet .
tub	The contents of a tub or the amount it can contain. Plant them in drifts at the front of your borders tub them fill a window box with them they go anywhere.
upstairs	On or to an upper floor of a building. An upstairs bedroom.
urinate	Pass after the manner of urine. The sick men urinate d blood.
