### Definitions of "Suite" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “suite” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A musical composition of several movements only loosely connected.*
- *Apartment consisting of a series of connected rooms used as a living unit (as in a hotel).*
- *A group of minerals, rocks, or fossils occurring together and characteristic of a location or period.*
- *A set of rooms designated for one person's or family's use or for a particular purpose.*
- *A set of coordinating furniture.*
- *A set of selected pieces from an opera or musical, arranged to be played as one instrumental work.*
- *A set of programs with a uniform design and the ability to share data.*
- *A matching set of furniture.*
- *The group following and attending to some important person.*
- *A group of people in attendance on a monarch or other person of high rank.*
- *A set of instrumental compositions, originally in dance style, to be played in succession.*



## Synonyms of "Suite" as a noun (15 Words)

<b><u>apartment</u></b>	A suite of rooms usually on one floor of an apartment house. <i>The Imperial <b>apartments</b>.</i>
<b>company</b>	Small military unit; usually two or three platoons. <i>He was silent among such distinguished <b>company</b>.</i>
<b>cortege</b>	The group following and attending to some important person.
<b>cortège</b>	A funeral procession.
<b>court</b>	The courtiers retinue and household of a sovereign. <i>The house was built around an inner <b>court</b>.</i>
<b><u>entourage</u></b>	A group of people attending or surrounding an important person. <i>An <b>entourage</b> of loyal courtiers.</i>
<b>following</b>	What follows or comes next. <i>He attracted a worldwide <b>following</b>.</i>

- retinue** A group of advisers, assistants, or others accompanying an important person.  
*The rock star s **retinue** of security guards and personal cooks.*
- rooms** Apartment consisting of a series of connected rooms used as a living unit as in a hotel.
- royal household** Stag with antlers of 12 or more branches.
- set of rooms** Being temporarily ready to respond in a particular way.
- staff** The body of teachers and administrators at a school.  
*The dean addressed the letter to the entire **staff** of the university.*
- suite of rooms** A matching set of furniture.
- train** A series of connected railway carriages or wagons moved by a locomotive or by integral motors.  
*The bride s **train** was carried by her two young nephews.*



## Usage Examples of "Suite" as a noun

- *A suite of reception rooms.*
- *The Royal Saloon was built for the use of the Queen and her suite.*
- *Potassic rock suites are a characteristic feature of the area.*
- *There is plenty of space for a dining table and a three-piece suite.*

<b>bathroom</b>	A set of matching units to be fitted in a bathroom especially as sold together. <i>I have to go to the <b>bathroom</b>.</i>
<b>bathtub</b>	A bath.
<u>bedroom</u>	A room for sleeping in. <i>All parents dream of children who tidy their <b>bedrooms</b> without being asked.</i>
<u>cabinet</u>	Housing for electronic instruments, as radio or television. <i>A cocktail <b>cabinet</b>.</i>
<u>chamber</u>	Place a bullet into the chamber of a gun. <i>He <b>chambered</b> a fresh cartridge.</i>
<b>cistern</b>	A tank that holds the water used to flush a toilet.
<u>console</u>	A small table fixed to a wall or designed to stand against a wall. <i>The bust of Napoleon stood on a <b>console</b>.</i>
<b>downstairs</b>	Situated downstairs. <i>I tripped over the cat and fell <b>downstairs</b>.</i>
<b>draining</b>	Having a debilitating effect.
<b>faucet</b>	A tap.
<b>furnishing</b>	The instrumentalities (furniture and appliances and other movable accessories including curtains and rugs) that make a home (or other area) livable. <i>A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious <b>furnishings</b>.</i>
<u>hotel</u>	A restaurant or cafe. <i>A <b>hotel</b> room.</i>
<b>house</b>	The management of a gambling house or casino. <i>It could be that I just <b>housed</b> a massive burrito but I don't feel good.</i>
<u>kitchen</u>	A set of fittings and units that are sold together and fixed in place in a kitchen. <i><b>Kitchen</b> Swahili.</i>
<b>lavatory</b>	A room, building, or cubicle containing a toilet or toilets. <i>She flushed the <b>lavatory</b>.</i>
<b>plumbing</b>	The work of installing and maintaining a plumbing system. <i>The kitchen has a gas cooker point and <b>plumbing</b> for an automatic washing machine.</i>
<b>restroom</b>	A toilet in a public building.
<u>room</u>	A set of rooms typically rented in which a person couple or family live. <i>Hardly enough elbow <b>room</b> to turn around.</i>
<b>sewer</b>	Someone who sews. <i>A <b>sewer</b> of fine gowns.</i>

<b>shower</b>	Take a shower wash one s body in the shower. <i>They installed a <b>shower</b> in the bathroom.</i>
<b>soap</b>	A soap opera. <i>She <b>soaped</b> her face.</i>
<b>stool</b>	Grow shoots in the form of stools or tillers. <i>Fibre in the child s diet will soften the <b>stools</b>.</i>
<b>taps</b>	(military) signal to turn the lights out.
<b>toilet</b>	A room building or cubicle containing a toilet or toilets. <i>A public <b>toilet</b>.</i>
<b>tub</b>	The contents of a tub or the amount it can contain. <i>Plant them in drifts at the front of your borders <b>tub</b> them fill a window box with them they go anywhere.</i>
<b>upstairs</b>	On or to an upper floor of a building. <i>An <b>upstairs</b> bedroom.</i>
<b>urinate</b>	Pass after the manner of urine. <i>The sick men <b>urinated</b> blood.</i>
