Definitions of "Suite" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “suite” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A musical composition of several movements only loosely connected.*
- *Apartment consisting of a series of connected rooms used as a living unit (as in a hotel).*
- *A group of minerals, rocks, or fossils occurring together and characteristic of a location or period.*
- *A set of rooms designated for one person's or family's use or for a particular purpose.*
- *A set of coordinating furniture.*
- *A set of selected pieces from an opera or musical, arranged to be played as one instrumental work.*
- *A set of programs with a uniform design and the ability to share data.*
- *A matching set of furniture.*
- *The group following and attending to some important person.*
- *A group of people in attendance on a monarch or other person of high rank.*
- *A set of instrumental compositions, originally in dance style, to be played in succession.*



Synonyms of "Suite" as a noun (15 Words)

<u>apartment</u>	A suite of rooms usually on one floor of an apartment house. <i>The Imperial apartments.</i>
company	Small military unit; usually two or three platoons. <i>He was silent among such distinguished company.</i>
cortege	The group following and attending to some important person.
cortège	A funeral procession.
court	The courtiers retinue and household of a sovereign. <i>The house was built around an inner court.</i>
<u>entourage</u>	A group of people attending or surrounding an important person. <i>An entourage of loyal courtiers.</i>
following	What follows or comes next. <i>He attracted a worldwide following.</i>

retinue	A group of advisers, assistants, or others accompanying an important person. <i>The rock star s retinue of security guards and personal cooks.</i>
rooms	Apartment consisting of a series of connected rooms used as a living unit as in a hotel.
royal household	Stag with antlers of 12 or more branches.
set of rooms	Being temporarily ready to respond in a particular way.
<u>staff</u>	The body of teachers and administrators at a school. <i>The dean addressed the letter to the entire staff of the university.</i>
suite of rooms	A matching set of furniture.
<u>train</u>	A series of connected railway carriages or wagons moved by a locomotive or by integral motors. <i>The bride s train was carried by her two young nephews.</i>



Usage Examples of "Suite" as a noun

- *A suite of reception rooms.*
- *The Royal Saloon was built for the use of the Queen and her suite.*
- *Potassic rock suites are a characteristic feature of the area.*
- *There is plenty of space for a dining table and a three-piece suite.*

bathroom	A set of matching units to be fitted in a bathroom especially as sold together. <i>I have to go to the bathroom.</i>
bathtub	A bath.
<u>bedroom</u>	A room for sleeping in. <i>All parents dream of children who tidy their bedrooms without being asked.</i>
<u>cabinet</u>	Housing for electronic instruments, as radio or television. <i>A cocktail cabinet.</i>
<u>chamber</u>	Place a bullet into the chamber of a gun. <i>He chambered a fresh cartridge.</i>
cistern	A tank that holds the water used to flush a toilet.
<u>console</u>	A small table fixed to a wall or designed to stand against a wall. <i>The bust of Napoleon stood on a console.</i>
downstairs	Situated downstairs. <i>I tripped over the cat and fell downstairs.</i>
draining	Having a debilitating effect.
faucet	A tap.
furnishing	The instrumentalities (furniture and appliances and other movable accessories including curtains and rugs) that make a home (or other area) livable. <i>A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious furnishings.</i>
<u>hotel</u>	A restaurant or cafe. <i>A hotel room.</i>
house	The management of a gambling house or casino. <i>It could be that I just housed a massive burrito but I don't feel good.</i>
<u>kitchen</u>	A set of fitments and units that are sold together and fixed in place in a kitchen. <i>Kitchen Swahili.</i>
lavatory	A room, building, or cubicle containing a toilet or toilets. <i>She flushed the lavatory.</i>
plumbing	The work of installing and maintaining a plumbing system. <i>The kitchen has a gas cooker point and plumbing for an automatic washing machine.</i>
restroom	A toilet in a public building.
<u>room</u>	A set of rooms typically rented in which a person couple or family live. <i>Hardly enough elbow room to turn around.</i>
sewer	Someone who sews. <i>A sewer of fine gowns.</i>

shower	Take a shower wash one s body in the shower. <i>They installed a shower in the bathroom.</i>
soap	A soap opera. <i>She soaped her face.</i>
stool	Grow shoots in the form of stools or tillers. <i>Fibre in the child s diet will soften the stools.</i>
taps	(military) signal to turn the lights out.
toilet	A room building or cubicle containing a toilet or toilets. <i>A public toilet.</i>
tub	The contents of a tub or the amount it can contain. <i>Plant them in drifts at the front of your borders tub them fill a window box with them they go anywhere.</i>
upstairs	On or to an upper floor of a building. <i>An upstairs bedroom.</i>
urinate	Pass after the manner of urine. <i>The sick men urinated blood.</i>
