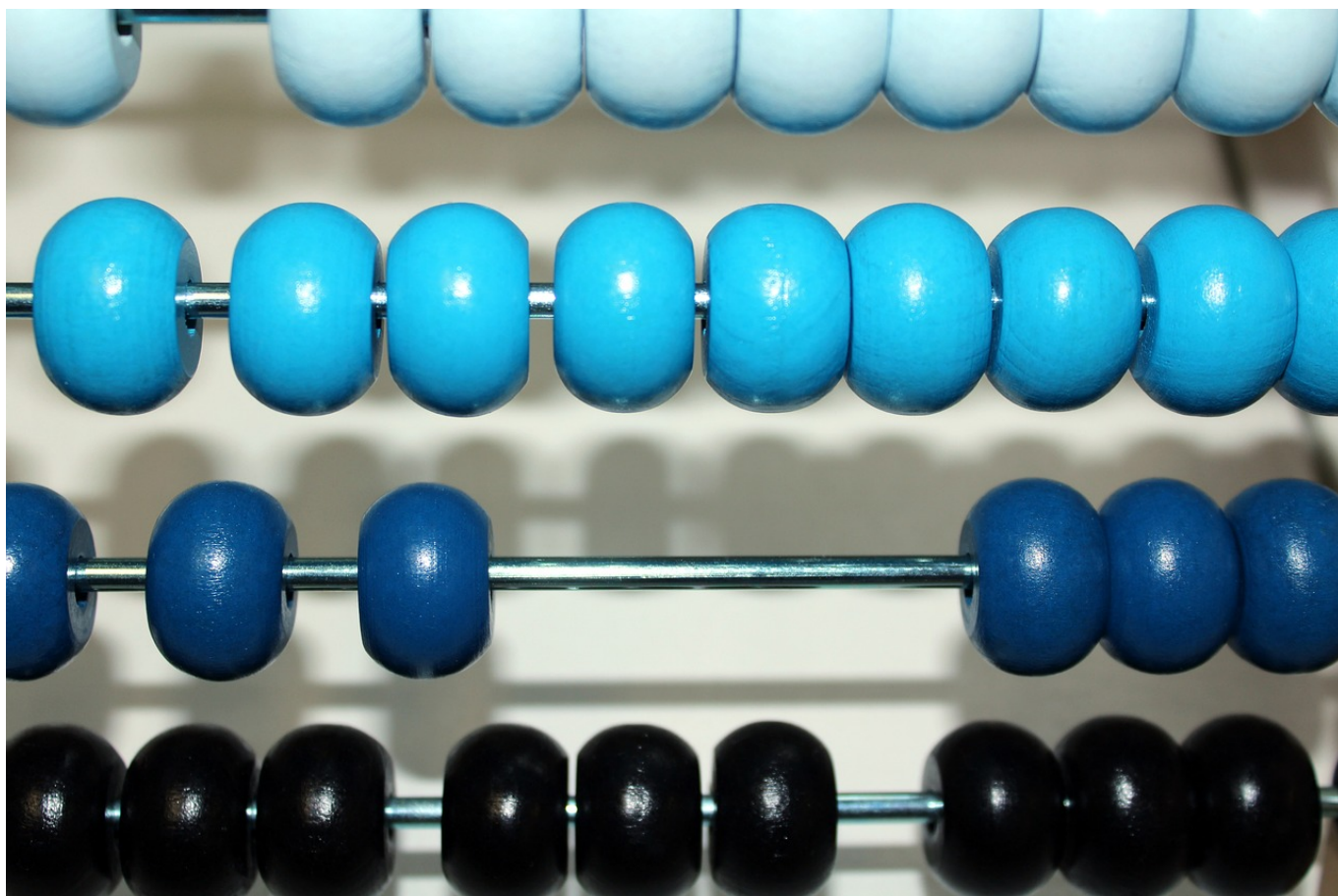

- *The process of adding things together.*
- *The process of summing something up.*
- *A sum total of things added together.*
- *The final aggregate.*
- *A concluding summary (as in presenting a case before a law court.*
- *(physiology) the process whereby multiple stimuli can produce a response (in a muscle or nerve or other part) that one stimulus alone does not produce.*

### **beginning and end**

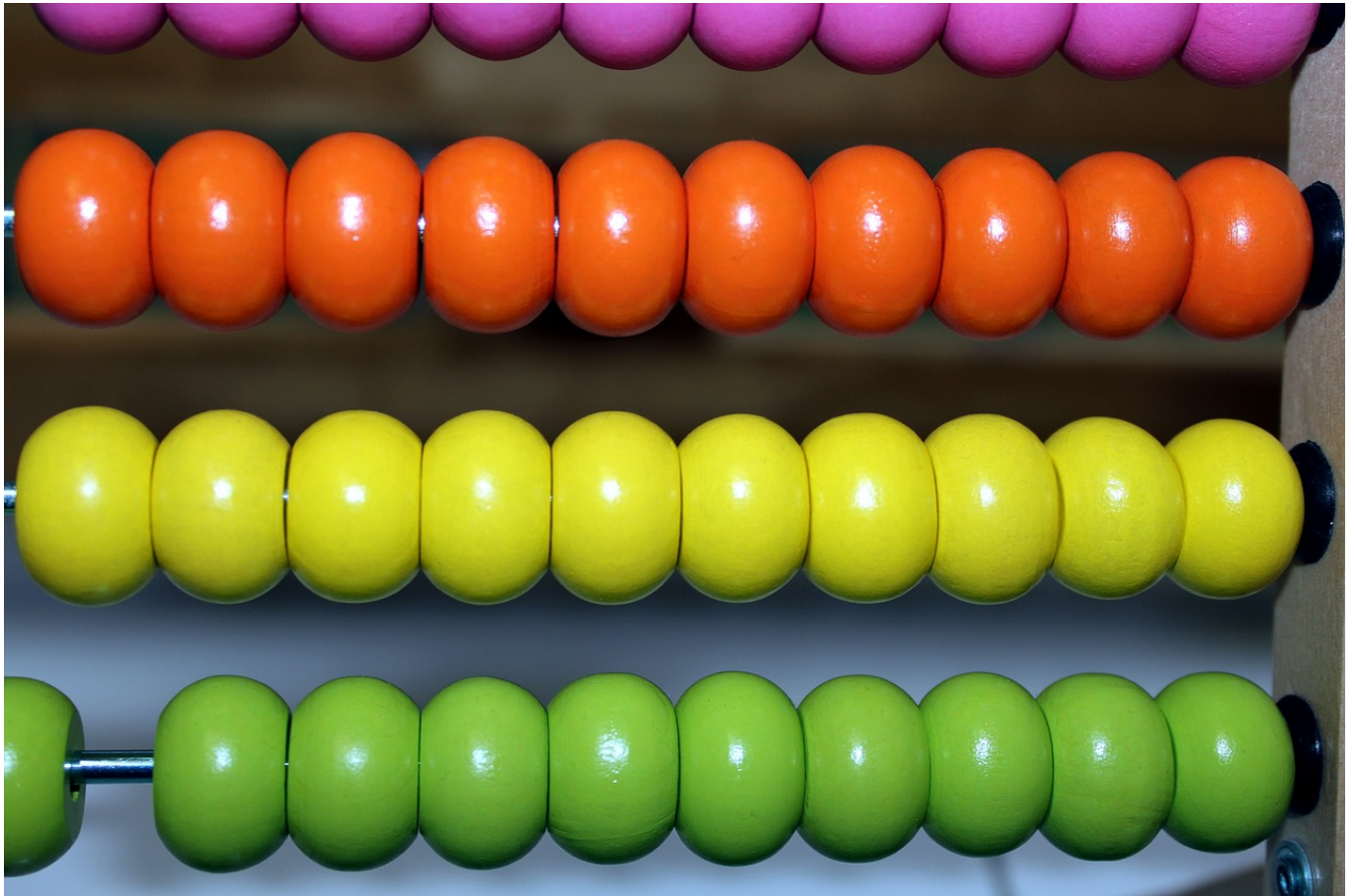
The place where something begins, where it springs into being.

<b>final decision</b>	The final match between the winners of all previous matches in an elimination tournament.
<b>final statement</b>	An examination administered at the end of an academic term.
<b>grand total</b>	The cardinal number that is the product of 10 and 100.
<b>gross</b>	A gross profit or income. <i>The box office <b>grosses</b> mounted.</i>
<b>outline</b>	A representation of a word in shorthand. <i>The chalked <b>outline</b> of a human body.</i>
<u><b>plus</b></u>	The arithmetic operation of summing; calculating the sum of two or more numbers. <i>A minus and a <b>plus</b> make another minus.</i>
<b>precis</b>	A summary or abstract of a text or speech.
<u><b>rundown</b></u>	An analysis or summary of something by a knowledgeable person. <i>A <b>rundown</b> in the business would be a devastating blow to the local economy.</i>
<u><b>sum</b></u>	A particular amount of money. <i>Do your <b>sums</b> then the shock will not be too great.</i>
<b>sum total</b>	The whole amount.
<b>summarization</b>	The act of preparing a summary (or an instance thereof); stating briefly and succinctly.
<b>summary</b>	A brief statement that presents the main points in a concise form. <i>He gave a <b>summary</b> of the conclusions.</i>
<b>summing up</b>	A quantity of money.
<u><b>synopsis</b></u>	A sketchy summary of the main points of an argument or theory. <i>A <b>synopsis</b> of the insurance cover provided is set out below.</i>
<u><b>tally</b></u>	An account kept by means of a tally. <i>I kept a <b>tally</b> of David's debt on a note above my desk.</i>
<u><b>total</b></u>	The whole amount. <i>He scored a <b>total</b> of thirty three points.</i>
<u><b>totality</b></u>	The whole of something. <i>Appalled by the <b>totality</b> of the destruction.</i>
<u><b>whole</b></u>	An assemblage of parts that is regarded as a single entity. <i>How big is that part compared to the <b>whole</b>.</i>



## Usage Examples of "Summation" as a noun

- *The summation of numbers of small pieces of evidence.*
- *Their value is no mere summation of the values of their component parts.*
- *Two summations of his work were published.*
- *These will need summation in a single document.*
- *The summation of four and three gives seven.*

### accessory

A small article or item of clothing carried or worn to complement a garment or outfit.

*Functionally the maxillae are a pair of **accessory** jaws.*

### add

Make an addition by combining numbers.

*A new wing was **added** to the building.*



<b>addition</b>	A person or thing added or joined. <i>The concepts of vectors and vector <b>addition</b>.</i>
<b>additional</b>	Further or added. <i>Called for <b>additional</b> troops.</i>
<b>additionally</b>	In addition, by way of addition; furthermore. <i><b>Additionally</b> 50 hours of practical experience will be necessary.</i>
<b>additive</b>	Characterized or produced by addition. <i>The combination of these factors has an <b>additive</b> effect.</i>
<b>adjunct</b>	A person who is another's assistant or subordinate. <i>A talented <b>adjunct</b> desperately grabbing at officer status.</i>
<b>dispensable</b>	Able to be replaced or done without; superfluous. <i><b>Dispensable</b> items of personal property.</i>
<b>except</b>	Take exception to. <i>Five classes of advertisement are <b>excepted</b> from control.</i>
<u><b>excess</b></u>	Excessive indulgence. <i>Bouts of alcoholic <b>excess</b>.</i>
<b>extra</b>	Excessive or extravagant. <i>Found some <b>extra</b> change lying on the dresser.</i>
<b>extraneous</b>	Not belonging to that in which it is contained; introduced from an outside source. <i><b>Extraneous</b> light in the camera spoiled the photograph.</i>
<b>helping</b>	A quantity of something. <i>It s a powerful ballad tinged with a huge <b>helping</b> of gospel vibes.</i>
<b>padding</b>	Artifact consisting of soft or resilient material used to fill or give shape or protect or add comfort. <i>Avoid waffle or <b>padding</b> in your essay.</i>
<u><b>plethora</b></u>	A large or excessive amount of something. <i>A <b>plethora</b> of committees and subcommittees.</i>
<u><b>plus</b></u>	(before a number) above zero; positive. <i>A minus and a <b>plus</b> make another minus.</i>
<b>redundance</b>	The attribute of being superfluous and unneeded.
<u><b>rundown</b></u>	A reduction in the productivity or activities of a company or institution. <i>A <b>rundown</b> in the business would be a devastating blow to the local economy.</i>
<u><b>spare</b></u>	Thin and fit. <i>The wheel s broken and it would be suicide to go on without a <b>spare</b>.</i>

<b>subsidiary</b>	Functioning in a supporting capacity. <i>All the firm's <b>subsidiary</b> companies have to operate under broad general guidelines.</i>
<b>superabundance</b>	A quantity that is more than what is appropriate.
<b>supererogatory</b>	More than is needed, desired, or required. <i>It was <b>supererogatory</b> of her to gloat.</i>
<b>superfluity</b>	An unnecessary thing. <i>They thought the garrison a <b>superfluity</b>.</i>
<b>superfluous</b>	Unnecessary, especially through being more than enough. <i>The purchaser should avoid asking for <b>superfluous</b> information.</i>
<b>supernumerary</b>	A supernumerary person or thing. <i>Extra ribs as well as other <b>supernumerary</b> internal parts.</i>
<b>supplementary</b>	A supplementary person or thing. <i>The programme offers <b>supplementary</b> information about the news.</i>
<b>surfeit</b>	Supply or feed to surfeit. <i>He died of a <b>surfeit</b>.</i>
<b><u>surplus</u></b>	More than what is needed or used; excess. <i>She had picked up her boots in an army <b>surplus</b> store.</i>
<b>unmerited</b>	Not merited. <i><b>Unmerited</b> treatment of a potentially fine subject.</i>
<b>unnecessary</b>	Unnecessary things. <i>Some people feel that holiday insurance is <b>unnecessary</b>.</i>
