Supernaturalise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **supernaturalise** We **supernaturalise**
You **supernaturalise** You **supernaturalise**
He/She/It **supernaturalises** They **supernaturalise**

Supernaturalise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am supernaturalising** We **are supernaturalising**
You **are supernaturalising** You **are supernaturalising**
He/She/It **is supernaturalising** They **are supernaturalising**

Supernaturalise in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have supernaturalised** We **have supernaturalised**
You **have supernaturalised** You **have supernaturalised**
He/She/It **has supernaturalised** They **have supernaturalised**

Supernaturalise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

I **have been supernaturalising** We **have been supernaturalising**
You **have been supernaturalising** You **have been supernaturalising**
He/She/It **has been supernaturalising** They **have been supernaturalising**

Supernaturalise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I was supernaturalising We were supernaturalising
You were supernaturalising You were supernaturalising
He/She/It was supernaturalising They were supernaturalising

Supernaturalise in Past Perfect Tense

I had supernaturalised We had supernaturalised
You had supernaturalised You had supernaturalised
He/She/It had supernaturalised They had supernaturalised

Supernaturalise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

I had been supernaturalising We had been supernaturalising
You had been supernaturalising You had been supernaturalising
He/She/It had been supernaturalising They had been supernaturalising

I will supernaturalise We will supernaturalise
You will supernaturalise You will supernaturalise
He/She/It will supernaturalise They will supernaturalise

I will be supernaturalising We will be supernaturalising
You will be supernaturalising You will be supernaturalising
He/She/It will be supernaturalising They will be supernaturalising
