champion	A person who has surpassed all rivals in a sporting contest or other competition. <i>A champion hurdler.</i>
genius	Someone who is dazzlingly skilled in any field. <i>Mozart was a child genius.</i>
giant	A very large company or organization. <i>Walton built a retail giant.</i>
great	A person who has achieved distinction and honor in some field. <i>The lives of the great including Churchill and Newton.</i>
guru	Each of the ten first leaders of the Sikh religion. <i>A guru of genomics.</i>
hotshot	Someone who is dazzlingly skilled in any field. <i>Their latest hotshot recruit.</i>
household name	A social unit living together.
king	A male sovereign ruler of a kingdom. <i>The lion is the king of beasts.</i>
leading light	The activity of leading.
master	Someone who holds a master's degree from academic institution. <i>The games master.</i>
maven	An expert or connoisseur. <i>The maven of vintage furniture.</i>
mavin	Someone who is dazzlingly skilled in any field.
mogul	An important or powerful person, especially in the film or media industry. <i>The Hollywood movie mogul Sam Goldwyn.</i>
name	(in the UK) an insurance underwriter belonging to a Lloyd's syndicate. <i>The big race will lure the top names.</i>

personality	A person of considerable prominence. <i>She is a Hollywood personality.</i>
sensation	The capacity to have physical sensations. <i>She had the eerie sensation that she was being watched.</i>
star	A conventional or stylized representation of a star typically having five or more points. <i>A sport star.</i>
virtuoso	A person with a special knowledge of or interest in works of art or curios. <i>A celebrated clarinet virtuoso.</i>
whizz	A fast movement or brief tour. <i>A quick whizz around the research and development facility.</i>
wiz	Someone who is dazzlingly skilled in any field.
wizard	Someone who is dazzlingly skilled in any field. <i>A financial wizard.</i>

- armada** A Spanish naval invasion force sent against England in 1588 by Philip II of Spain. It was defeated by the English fleet and almost completely destroyed by storms off the Hebrides.
*An **armada** of destroyers minesweepers and gunboats.*
- asterisk** Mark with an asterisk.
*He had **asterisked** the things about the case that still bothered him.*
- astral** Being or relating to or resembling or emanating from stars.
***Astral** navigation.*
- astronomical** (of an amount) extremely large.
***Astronomical** observations.*
- cadenza** A virtuoso solo passage inserted into a movement in a concerto or other musical work, typically near the end.
- celebrity** A widely known person.
*A **celebrity** chef.*
- champion** Protect or fight for as a champion.
*A **champion** show dog.*

constellation	An arrangement of parts or elements. <i>No two patients ever show exactly the same constellation of symptoms.</i>
disco	Popular dance music especially in the late 1970s melodic with a regular bass beat intended mainly for dancing at discotheques. <i>The Bee Gees disco classic Staying Alive.</i>
diva	A self-important person who is temperamental and difficult to please (typically used of a woman). <i>She is much more the dedicated maverick than the petulant diva.</i>
galaxy	The galaxy of which the solar system is a part the Milky Way. <i>The four musicians have played with a galaxy of stars.</i>
genius	Someone who has exceptional intellectual ability and originality. <i>He sees Adams as the man s evil genius.</i>
glamorous	(of a person) having a beauty or charm that is sexually attractive. <i>One of the world s most glamorous women.</i>
hero	Someone who fights for a cause. <i>Jumpsuits are hands down our hottest hero piece right now.</i>
illuminate	Decorate (a building or structure) with lights for a special occasion. <i>His face was illuminated by a smile.</i>
javelin	An athletic competition in which a javelin is thrown as far as possible. <i>His nearest rival in the javelin.</i>
masterful	Performed or performing very skilfully. <i>A masterful speaker.</i>
maven	Someone who is dazzlingly skilled in any field. <i>Fashion mavens call beige oatmeal.</i>
pentagram	A star with 5 points; formed by 5 straight lines between the vertices of a pentagon and enclosing another pentagon.
planetarium	A building housing an instrument for projecting the positions of the planets onto a domed ceiling.
pluto	A cartoon character created by Walt Disney.
polestar	The brightest star in Ursa Minor; at the end of the handle of the Little Dipper; the northern axis of the earth points toward it.
pugilist	A boxer, especially a professional one.
singer	United States inventor of an improved chain-stitch sewing machine (1811-1875). <i>A pop singer.</i>
sparkle	Be vivacious and witty. <i>There was a sparkle in his eyes.</i>

<u>star</u>	A conventional or stylized representation of a star typically having five or more points. <i>A sport star.</i>
<u>stellar</u>	Being or relating to or resembling or emanating from stars. <i>Stellar structure and evolution.</i>
virgo	(astrology) a person who is born while the sun is in Virgo.
virtuoso	A musician who is a consummate master of technique and artistry. <i>A celebrated clarinet virtuoso.</i>
<u>winner</u>	A gambler who wins a bet. <i>A Nobel Prize winner.</i>
